

1                                   **RESOLUTION NO. 20190822-0XX**

2           **WHEREAS**, the City of Austin seeks to repurpose the Faulk Library into a  
3 new history center and archival repository (Project); and

4           **WHEREAS**, expenditures for the Project will exceed \$50,000; and

5           **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Local Government Code Section 252.021(a),  
6 before entering into a contract that requires an expenditure of more than  
7 \$50,000.00, the City must: (1) comply with Subchapters B and C of Chapter 252,  
8 Local Government Code (Chapter 252) related to competitive bidding and  
9 proposals; (2) use the reverse auction procedure defined by Section 2155.062(d) of  
10 the Government Code, for purchasing; or (3) comply with a method described by  
11 Chapter 2269 of the Texas Government Code (Chapter 2269); and

12           **WHEREAS**, Subchapter F of Chapter 2269, Government Code,  
13 “Construction Manager-at-Risk Method,” describes the manager-at-risk method  
14 authorized by that subchapter as a project delivery method by which a  
15 governmental entity contracts with an architect or engineer for design and  
16 construction phase services and contracts separately with a construction manager-  
17 at-risk to serve as the general contractor and to provide consultation during the  
18 design and construction, rehabilitation, alteration, or repair of a facility; and

19           **WHEREAS**, Section 2269.056(a) of the Government Code provides that the  
20 governing body of a governmental entity that considers a construction contract  
21 using a method authorized by Chapter 2269 other than competitive bidding must,  
22 before advertising, determine which method provides the best value for the  
23 governmental entity; and

24           **WHEREAS**, in relation to the Project specifics and requirements, staff has  
25 considered the methods described in Chapter 2269 and reviewed the procedures  
26 described in Chapter 252; and

27           **WHEREAS**, with respect to the Project and the expenditures necessary to  
28 complete it, staff recommends use of the construction manager-at-risk method for  
29 buildings authorized by Subchapter F, Chapter 2269, Government Code as the  
30 project delivery method that provides the best value for the City; **NOW**,  
31 **THEREFORE**,

32 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

33           The City Council finds that with respect to expenditures necessary for the  
34 project of repurposing the existing Faulk Library into a new history center and  
35 archival repository; the construction manager-at-risk method described by  
36 Subchapter F of Chapter 2269 of the Texas Government Code provides the best  
37 value for the City.
