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WHEREAS, the City, through its Economic Development Department, Cultural Arts Division, serves to encourage, develop, and facilitate an enriched environment of artistic, creative, and cultural activity in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Arts Commission, along with the Cultural Arts Division, developed a funding plan based on the model adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 20050818-007 on August 18, 2005; and

WHEREAS, City Council reaffirms its support of language in the agreements for Zachary Scott Theatre regarding labor matters in the contract for the upcoming year; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

27 The City Council approves the award of contracts for cultural arts services
28 for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 to the contractors listed in the attached Exhibit "A" in
29 the corresponding amounts, subject to adjustment as set out below, in a total
30 amount not to exceed \$8,654,255 and authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and
31 execute these contracts with terms and conditions as may be favorable, necessary,
32 or required; and

33 **BE IT FURTHER RESOVLED:**

34 The City Council authorizes payment in the amount of \$60,000 for Zachary
35 Scott Theatre for maintenance and operations, per a separate, current operations
36 agreement, to be paid from the Cultural Arts Fund, with the additional direction to
37 the City Manager that the labor peace language from the 2016-2017 agreement be
38 included in the new agreement, and that language also be added to that agreement
39 and in the award of the cultural arts grant to require return of funds paid to Zachary
40 Scott Theatre from the City in the event of a determination of violation of labor
41 law by a federal court of appeals with competent jurisdiction over the matter;

42 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

43 The City Council authorizes payment in the amount of \$25,000 each to the
44 Austin Fine Arts Alliance, the Capital City Black Film Festival, and the Mexic-
45 Arte Museum for marketing through the Austin Convention Center Department's
46 operating budget.

47 **BE IT FURTHER RESOVLED:**

48 The City Manager or his designee is authorized to make formula-based
49 adjustments to funding amounts not to exceed the amount of his administrative
50 authority, based on the arts funding matrix approved by City Council and as
51 necessary to correct mathematical or categorization errors, or based on updated

52 financial information.
