ORDINANCE NO. <u>20180510-056</u>

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-1-206 OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO THE JOINT SUSTAINABILITY COMMITTEE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Subsections (A) and (B) of City Code Section 2-1-206 (*Joint Sustainability Committee*) are amended to read:

§ 2-1-206 JOINT SUSTAINABILITY COMMITTEE.

(A) The council creates the Joint Sustainability Committee of the:

(1) Community Development Commission;

(2) Design Commission;

[(2)](3) Economic Prosperity Commission;

[(3)](4) Electric Utility Commission;

[(4)](5) Environmental Commission;

[(5)](6) Parks and Recreation Board;

[(6)](7) Planning Commission;

[(7)](8) Resource Management Commission;

[(8)](9) Austin-Travis County Food Policy Board;

[(9)](10) Urban Transportation Commission;

[(10)](11) Water and Waste Water Commission; and

[(11)](12) Zero Waste Advisory Commission.

(B) Each of the boards enumerated in Subsection (A) shall select one of its members to serve on the joint committee. Each of the boards shall also designate a second member to serve in case the designated member cannot attend a meeting of the committee.

PART 2. City Code Section 2-1-206 (*Joint Sustainability Committee*) is amended to add a new Subsection (D), and to renumber the remaining Subsections accordingly:

(D) <u>To ensure adequate community stakeholder representation, the council committee assigned oversight of social service policies will nominate one individual to serve on the joint committee. A nomination to the joint committee under this subsection is subject to approval by a majority vote of the council.</u>

PART 3. This ordinance takes effect on May 21, 2018. Those members serving on the joint committee at the time this ordinance takes effect will serve the remainder of their term.
