The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is widening U.S. Highway 290 from west of Ranch-to-Market 1826 To State Highway Loop 1, locally known as Oak Hill Parkway. In connection with that improvement project, TxDOT has identified the need to acquire a .144-acre segment of land owned by the City of Austin and stewarded by Austin Water Utility (AWU). The land was once part of the now decommissioned Oak Hill Pump Station #2. AWU has confirmed that conveying this portion of the decommissioned pump station site to TxDOT will not compromise their current or future operations in the area. TxDOT has made an offer to purchase the subject property at an appraised value of \$1,000. The Office of Real Estate Services has reviewed the appraisal provided by TxDOT and determined its value conclusion to be reasonably supported.

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
