

AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 2019

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a special called meeting on Wednesday, September 18, 2019 in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 301 West Second Street, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Adler called the Council Meeting to order at 2:21 p.m.
