At the Regular Meeting of the City Council on September 19, 2019, Council took up Item 102 and conducted a public hearing, in accordance with Texas Parks and Wildlife Code Chapter 26, to consider authorizing a change in use of dedicated parkland, known as the Onion Creek greenbelt, for the extension of Meadow Lake Blvd, west of S. Pleasant Valley Road. There were no speakers on the item and a motion to close the public hearing and approve Resolution No. 20190919-102 was approved on Mayor Pro Tem Garza's motion, Council Member Alter's second on an 11-0 vote.
