Adler Additional Direction V2

The City Council approves and authorizes the City Manager to sign the Automatic Aid Agreement as proposed by Austin Fire Department Chief Baker on the December 5, 2019 City Council agenda. The City Council directs the City Manager to have the Austin Fire Chief coordinate with Travis and Williamson County automatic aid partners to create a universal regional fire response operating guideline and to report back to City Council on progress in 12 months. Chief Baker is further directed to coordinate with AFA regarding a universal fire response guideline.

The City Manager is directed to give City Council 45-day notice before the City agrees to:

- Any changes to Sections: IV.A.1, IV.A.2, IV.A.3, IV.A.7, IV.A.10, or IV.A.11 of the final draft of the Operational Guidelines that are proposed and agreed to by all parties.
- Any changes to the operating systems in use by jurisdictions at the time of the agreement's initial execution

City Council can direct, without limitation, the City Manager to terminate the city's participation in the auto aid agreement if any unacceptable changes are made thereto.
