18	3. the City Council held a hearing at which public comment could be made on the
19	Development as required by Subsection (b); and
20	4. after due consideration of the information provided by the Applicant and public
21	comment, the City Council does not object to the Applicant's application to the

BE II FURTHER RESULVED:
Pursuant to Section 11.3 of Texas' Qualified Allocation Plan, the City Council
expressly acknowledges and confirms that the City has more than twice the state average
of units per capita supported by Housing Tax Credits or Private Activity Bonds.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:
Pursuant to Section 2306.6703(a)(4) of the Texas Government Code and Sections
11.3 and 11.4 of Texas' Qualified Allocation Plan, the City Council supports the
Development; approves the construction of the Development; and authorizes an allocation
of Housing Tax Credits for the Development.
