Additional Backup Information:

During the 86th Texas Legislature, Senate Bill 21 (SB21) was passed and signed by the Governor, which necessitates amendments to Chapters 10-4 and 10-11 of the City Code. The needed Code amendments are summarized below and detailed in the attached draft ordinance.

SB21 amends current state law related to the lawful age for the sale or delivery of cigarettes, tobacco products, or electronic smoking devices by increasing the lawful age from 18 to 21 years of age. An exception was made for members of the US or State Military Forces, for whom the legal age to purchase tobacco remains 18 years of age, as well as individuals born on or before August 31, 2001.
