The Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA) recently released the Ending Homelessness Fund (EHF) f cities receiving other TDHCA funding for homeless services. These funds come from the voluntary contributions of Texa during Vehicle Registration. This is the first-year allocations will be made available from the EHF. On June 5, 2019, the Cit received notification of a funding allocation for Austin in the amount of \$35,135. On November 25, 2019, the City received contract documents from TDHCA to complete for a program period of December 1, 2019 to November 30, 2020. Aust Public Health will allocate EHF to provide financial assistance to support the new HHSP-Youth Set Aside Program of Contractions, transitional housing, case management, street outreach and housing assistance for homeless youth and your
