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4	WHEREAS, a public improvement district ("PID") is an economic
5	development tool authorized by Texas Local Government Code Chapter 372 (the
6	"Statute") that provides for the financing of public improvements and supplemental
7	services that are determined by a municipality or county to confer a special benefit
8	on a geographically defined area within the municipality's corporate limits or
9	extraterritorial jurisdiction or the county's boundaries; and
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11	WHEREAS, a Development PID is a special purpose district created to help
12	spur economic development by providing a means to finance the costs of
13	infrastructure that benefit and promote development within a definable part of the
14	City, with such costs being borne by the property owners within the PID boundaries
15	who receive special benefits from the public improvements; and
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17	WHEREAS, a Maintenance and Operations PID is an economic
18	development district that allows property owners within a specific geographic area
19	to benefit from enhanced services and public improvements that specifically benefit
20	properties located within the PID; and
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WHEREAS, the original City PID Policy was adopted in 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City has authorized the creation of three Development
PIDs and three Maintenance and Operations PIDs; and

WHEREAS, the original PID Policy should be updated because of its age

and because it does not provide policies specifically pertaining to Maintenance andOperations PIDs; and

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WHEREAS, a team consisting of representatives from Austin Water, 32 33 Development Services, Economic Development, Financial Services, Law, Neighborhood Housing and Development, Parks and Recreation, Planning and 34 Zoning, Public Works, and Transportation and Watershed Protection developed the 35 proposed updated PID Policy. In developing the proposed Policy, the team 36 reviewed the requirements of the Statute, best practices, and the PID 37 38 policies of other Texas cities and counties, and received input from internal and 39 external stakeholders; NOW, THEREFORE,
