3	WHEREAS, the City of Austin seeks to upgrade or replace the Austin
4	Convention Center event space lighting automation system with the Convention
5	Center North and South Side Event Space Lighting project (Project); and
6	WHEREAS, expenditures for the Project will exceed \$50,000; and
7	WHEREAS, pursuant to Local Government Code Section 252.021(a),
8	before entering into a contract that requires an expenditure of more than
9	\$50,000.00, the City must: (1) comply with Subchapters B and C of Chapter 252,
0	Local Government Code (Chapter 252) related to competitive bidding and
1	proposals; (2) use the reverse auction procedure defined by Section 2155.062(d) of
2	the Government Code, for purchasing; or (3) comply with a method described by
13	Chapter 2269 of the Texas Government Code (Chapter 2269); and
4	WHEREAS, Subchapter D of Chapter 2269, Government Code,
5	(Competitive Sealed Proposal), describes the competitive sealed proposal method
6	authorized by that subchapter as a procurement method by which a governmental
17	entity requests proposals, ranks the offerors, negotiates as prescribed, and then
8	contracts with a general contractor for the construction, rehabilitation, alteration, or
9	repair of a facility; and
20	WHEREAS, Section 2269.056(a) of the Government Code provides that the
21	governing body of a governmental entity that considers a construction contract
22	using a method authorized by Chapter 2269 other than competitive bidding must,
23	before advertising, determine which method provides the best value for the
24	governmental entity; and

25	WHEREAS, in relation to the Project specifics and requirements, staff has
26	considered the methods described in Chapter 2269 and reviewed the procedures
27	described in Chapter 252; and
28	WHEREAS, with respect to the Project and the expenditures necessary to
29	complete it, staff recommends use of the competitive sealed proposal method for
30	procurement authorized by Subchapter D, Chapter 2269, Government Code
31	(Competitive Sealed Proposal Method) as the project delivery method that
32	provides the best value for the City; NOW, THEREFORE,
33	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:
34	The City Council finds that with respect to expenditures necessary for the
35	Convention Center North and South Side Event Space Lighting project to upgrade
36	or replace the Austin Convention Center event space lighting automation system,
37	the competitive sealed proposal method described by Subchapter D of Chapter
38	2269 of the Texas Government Code (Competitive Sealed Proposal) provides the
39	best value for the City.
