### **Additional Backup Information:**

The Mayor may sign a Declaration of Local State of Disaster that is valid and in effect for seven days. A Declaration of Local State of Disaster may not extend beyond seven days unless it is then ratified and extended by the City Council. Upon ratification and agreement to continue by the Council, the Declaration of Local State of Disaster is in effect until it is terminated. Mayor Adler signed the Declaration of Local State of Disaster on March 6, 2020, due to concerns related to coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).
