


Current Confirmed Cases (as of 03/09/2020)

- PHASE 5: Sustained Person-to-Person Spread



Mass Gatherings

- Mass Gatherings > 2500 attendance
 - Events > 2500 attendees are prohibited by Disaster Declaration
 - Requirement for an Infectious Disease Mitigation Plan
 - Plan must be approved by Austin Public Health <u>prior to</u> proceeding with the event
- Gathering <2500 attendance
 - Recommendation for an Infectious Disease Mitigation Plan
 - Recommendations for risk assessment and mitigation strategies will be provided in consultation with APH



Planning and Response Activities

Austin Public Health Department Operation Center Activities

- Hospital/Clinic: triage regarding potential suspect cases
- EMS: triage of 9-1-1 callers
- General Public Call Navigation: 311
- Coordination of testing and sample collection
- Social services support for those individuals under Health Authority control orders
- IT: GIS support for current and future needs



Planning and Response Activities

HSEM Emergency Operations Center Activities

- Joint Information Services
- Daily reporting of regional counts
 - ICU beds
 - Isolation beds
- Contingency planning for surge
- Telehealth surge capacity
