Item 81 direction

The City Manager is directed to assess whether providers receiving these funds may need technical assistance to alter or pivot their service models in order to swiftly disburse dollars directly to residents or to scale their current operations. The City Manager is further directed to identify available city funds or other resources that may be used to offer such capacity building assistance.

Item 81 amendments

Please find below proposed friendly amendments to Item 81:

- 1. In the Service Provider section, on page 8, after line 142, add the following language:
 - The City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute emergency contracts or contract amendments (as appropriate) with one or more providers to work with those who have tested positive for COVID-19 or have a high probability of infection (based on contact tracing), so that those individuals receive assistance tailored to their needs and are better able to comply with containment measures.
- 2. In the Eligibility section, on page 7, after line 126, add the following language:
 - Prioritize individuals eligible for RISE funds, who have also tested positive for COVID-19 or have a high probability of infection based on contact tracing, while maintaining appropriate confidentiality.
