29	Pursuant to Section 2306.6703(a)(4) of the Texas Government Code and Sections
30	11.3 and 11.4 of Texas' 2020 Qualified Allocation Plan, the City Council supports the
31	proposed Development; approves the construction of the Development; and authorizes an
32	allocation of Housing Tax Credits for the Development.

34	The City Council authorizes, empowers, and directs Jannette S. Goodall, City Clerk,
35	to certify this resolution to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs.
