Prior Council Action:

January 23, 2014 - Council approved Resolution No. 20140123-27, authorizing negotiation and execution of an interlocal agreement with Travis County, through Travis County Services for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, for sign language interpretation services for the Health and Human Services Department and Municipal Court in an amount not to exceed \$43,500 annually. The item passed on a 6-0 vote, with Mayor Leffingwell was absent.

Additional Backup Information:

In 2014, the City entered into an interlocal agreement with Travis County through which the County provides sign language interpreters for Municipal Court and Austin Public Health. Travis County has now agreed to also provide Computer Assisted Realtime Transcription (CART) services to Austin Public Health and Municipal Court, as requested by City, and this amendment to the agreement memorializes the Parties' agreement concerning the County's provision of these CART services.

The Municipal Court utilizes interpreter services at the Municipal Courthouse, the Downtown Austin Community Court and Central Booking. The Court is statutorily required to provide verbatim translation for defendants by persons certified by the State of Texas to translate court proceedings in the State of Texas.
