2	WHEREAS, the City is currently a party to an interlocal agreement with the
4	Texas Department of Public Safety to participate in a program operated by
5	OmniBase Services of Texas, which places holds on driver license renewals when
6	individuals miss court or payments on Class C misdemeanors until the tickets are
7	completely resolved; and
8	WHEREAS, individuals who are unable to renew their licenses due to the
9	OmniBase program often become trapped in a cycle of debt when they must
10	continue to drive in order to resolve their tickets and provide for their families,
11	thereby risking more tickets and holds for driving without a valid license; and
12	WHEREAS, the OmniBase program is optional, and jurisdictions that
13	choose not to participate have similar collection rates to those that do; and
14	WHEREAS, the City's interlocal agreement for participation in the
15	OmniBase program expires July 16, 2020, will not automatically renew, and will
16	require Council action to be renewed; and
17	WHEREAS, the OmniBase program is contrary to the City's goals of
18	advancing economic mobility and fair administration of justice; NOW,
19	THEREFORE,
20	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

22	The City Manager is directed to not renew the current interlocal agreement
23	with the Texas Department of Public Safety for participation in the OmniBase
24	program when it expires.
