

ORDINANCE NO. 20200507-057

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 GENERAL FUND EMERGENCY RESERVE FUND (ORDINANCE 20190910-001) TO APPROPRIATE AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,200,000 TO SUPPORT EMERGENCY FOOD ACCESS FOR HOUSEHOLDS IMPACTED BY COVID-19; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. FINDINGS. Council adopts the findings and purposes stated in the resolution relating to the use of these funds for emergency food access for caregivers of students who are in Austin area schools who need emergency food access due to funding emergencies resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic and related government actions taken to halt the spread of the disease.


PART 2. Council amends the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 General Fund Emergency Reserve Fund (Ordinance No. 20190910-001) to appropriate an amount not to exceed \$2,200,000 to fund emergency food access for caregivers of students who are in Austin area schools in need of such food because the households are impacted by COVID-19.

PART 3. The COVID-19 pandemic and related emergency declarations and orders constitute an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the preservation of the public's health and safety.


