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WHEREAS, LDG The Henderson on Reinli, LP (Applicant), its successors, assigns or affiliates, proposes to construct an affordable multi-family housing development of approximately 308 units to be located at or near 1101 Reinli Street, Austin, Texas, 78723 (Development) within the City of Austin; and

WHEREAS, Applicant, its successors, assigns or affiliates, intends to submit an application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA) for 4% Low Income Housing Tax Credits for the Development to be known as The Henderson on Reinli; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

In accordance with Section 2306.67071 of the Texas Government Code, the City Council finds that:

1. the Applicant provided notice to the City Council as required by Subsection (a); and
2. the City Council had sufficient opportunity to obtain a response from the Applicant regarding any questions or concerns about the proposed Development; and
3. the City Council has held a hearing at which public comment could be made on the proposed Development as required by Subsection (b); and

20 4. after due consideration of the information provided by the Applicant and public
21 comment, the City Council does not object to the Applicant's proposed
22 application to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs.

23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

24 Pursuant to Section 11.3(c) of Texas' 2020 Qualified Allocation Plan and Section
25 2306.6703(a)(4) of the Texas Government Code, the City Council expressly
26 acknowledges and confirms that the City has more than twice the state average of units
27 per capita supported by Housing Tax Credits or Private Activity Bonds.

28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

29 Pursuant to Section 11.3 and 11.4 of Texas' 2020 Qualified Allocation Plan, the
30 City Council acknowledges that the proposed Development is located in a census tract
31 that has more than 20% Housing Tax Credit Units per total households.

32 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

33 Pursuant to Section 2306.6703(a)(4) of the Texas Government Code and Sections
34 11.3 and 11.4 of Texas' 2020 Qualified Allocation Plan, the City Council supports the
35 proposed Development; approves the construction of the Development; authorizes an
36 allocation of Housing Tax Credits for the Development; and affirms that the
37 Development is consistent with the City's obligation to affirmatively further fair
38 housing.

The City Council authorizes, empowers, and directs Jannette S. Goodall, City Clerk, to certify this resolution to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs.
