

AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING TUESDAY, APRIL 28, 2020

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a special called meeting on Tuesday, April 28, 2020 via Videoconference.

Mayor Adler called the Council Meeting to order at 9:02 a.m.

DISCUSSION ITEM

1. Discussion related to COVID-19 matters.

Presentation was given by Dr. Lauren Meyers, University of Texas, Dr. Dean Clay Johnston, Dell Medical School, and Dr. Mark Escott, Medical Director, City of Austin.

Direction was given to staff to work on a new communication strategy regarding the switch in testing strategy to include the possibility of anyone who has at least one symptom.
