Additional Backup Information:

The hike and bike trail ("Trail") will be a minimum of 12' wide with a concrete surface and wind in and out of the floodplain and possible active flow areas with proper drainage details. It is expected to be around 9,400 linear feet long, which will approximate 2.6 acres of improved pathway. Appropriate signage for safety, education, and direction will be installed. The County will ensure compliance with Federal Aviation Administration regulations, including any specifications for lighting. An historical site on Airport near the Trail, Moore's Cabin, will be preserved by the Travis County Historic Commission.

The County will be responsible for the development and completion of the engineering design, plans, and specifications for the Trail. This includes any required surveying, permitting, and environmental assessments. Construction plans will be provided for the Airport's review and approval prior to the Trail's construction.

The County will be responsible for full expenses of the Project, and for managing the scope, cost, and schedule, as well as assume full responsibility for maintenance and operation after construction of the Trail is complete.

The Airport property that will consist of the Trail will not be dedicated parkland and will not be managed by the City of Austin Parks and Recreation Department.
