#### Additional Backup Information:

In 2016, the first phase of the elevator refurbishment began and modernized Garage Elevators 1-6 and Terminal Elevators 3-5. The remaining elevators have been repackaged and submitted as Phase 2 of this program. Phase 2 includes elevators 1, 2A and 2B, 8 and 13.

The elevators are beyond their service life and are subject to failure. This project will modernize the elevator systems and improve the reliability of the elevators that provide necessary access to the different levels of the airport terminal building.

This item includes one allowance of \$45,000 to address Cummins Emergency Power Coordination. An allowance is an amount that is specified and included in the construction contract or specifications for a certain

item(s) of work whose details are not yet determined at the time of bidding.

Due to the potential for unknown conditions present at the site, a 10% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any change orders. A contingency is an additional amount of money added to the construction budget to cover any unforeseen construction costs associated with the project.

The contract allows 260 Calendar days for completion of this project. This project is located within zip code 78719 (District 2). The project will be managed by Department of Aviation.
