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WHEREAS, the City's proposed FY 2020-21 Community Development Program and annual Action Plan will use the Federal HUD Grant and local funding; and

1. identified in its Fiscal Years 2019-2024 Consolidated Plan, adopted on June 6, 2019, areas of the municipality in which predominantly low- and moderate-income persons reside, or that are blighted or slum areas; and
2. established in its Fiscal Years 2019-2024 Consolidated Plan, adopted on June 6, 2019, community development program areas in which community development activities, building rehabilitation, or the acquisition of privately owned buildings or land are proposed; and
3. adopted a Citizen Participation Plan (CCP) under which residents may

publicly comment on proposed community development programs and the annual Action Plan (Resolution No. 960328-31, as amended by Resolution Nos. 000113-29, 040129-8, 20111215-089, and 20200521-014); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 373.006(4) and Part 91, Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the City Council conducted public hearings, on April 23, 2020 and July 30, 2020, to obtain public comment on the proposed Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 373.006(4) and Part 91, Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the Community Development Commission conducted a public hearing on July 15, 2020, to obtain public comment on the proposed Action Plan and made its final recommendation on the proposed Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City made the proposed Action Plan available for a 30-day public comment period beginning on July 15, 2020; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council approves the FY 2020-21 Action Plan (attached to this resolution and identified as Exhibit A) and related Funding Table (attached to this resolution and identified as Exhibit B).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The City Council authorizes the City Manager to submit, attest, execute, and

42 deliver the necessary grant applications, certifications, and other related documents
43 including, but not limited to, applications, a final statement of community development
44 objectives, and projected use of funds, and any required certifications;, and to
45 negotiate, as necessary, with HUD for the Federal HUD Grant.
