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¹ On November 28, 2017, complaints were filed against 19 lobbyists, in which the complainant alleged failure to disclose client compensation in violation of section 4-8-6(A)(2) of the City Code. Between November 29, 2017 and February 7, 2018, the complainant advised that he was satisfied each of the 19 respondents to the complaints had either filed corrected reports or otherwise resolved the failure to report allegations. At a preliminary hearing on February 7, 2018, the Ethics Review Commission dismissed the 19 complaints.
