Approve negotiation and execution of Amendment No. 9 to the agreement with African American Youth Harvest Foundation for the provision of youth development conferences, adding one 12-month extension option beginning October 1, 2020 in an amount not to exceed \$83,362, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$569,277.

Funding in the amount of \$83,362 will be available in the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Austin Public Health Department's Operating Budget.

Prior Council Action:

August 8, 2019 - Council approved Amendment No. 8 adding one 12-month extension option beginning October 1, 2019 in amount not to exceed \$83,362, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$485,915, on an 11-0 vote.

August 7, 2014 - Council approved a contract with African American Youth Harvest Foundation for youth development conferences beginning October 1, 2014, with four 12-month renewal options, on a 7-0 vote.

Approval of this item will authorize Austin Public Health to negotiate and execute Amendment No. 9 to the agreement with African American Youth Harvest Foundation (AAYHF) for the continued provision of African American Youth Conferences at select Austin Independent School District middle and high schools.

Austin Public Health has contracted with AAYHF since 2012 to hold a series of conferences for African American Youth at select AISD schools. AAYHF is a non-profit organization that works cooperatively with local school districts and institutions of higher education to identify barriers preventing academic achievement and eliminate the academic achievement gap between African American and Caucasian students. AAYHF staff develop strategies designed to reduce the dropout rate and mitigate underachievement in academic performance of African American students.

Amendment No. 8 added an extension option beginning October 1, 2018 for \$83,362.

Amendment No. 7 exercised the fourth 12-month extension option beginning October 1, 2018 for \$83,362.

Amendment No. 6 added a 2.5% cost of living increase in the amount of \$2,033, which was approved by Council for Fiscal Year 2017-2018.

Amendment No. 5 exercised the third 12-month extension option beginning October 1, 2017 for \$81,329.

Amendment No. 4 added a 2.3% cost of living increase in the amount of \$1,829, which was approved by Council for Fiscal Year 2016-2017.

Amendment No. 3 exercised the second 12-month extension option beginning October 1, 2016 for \$79,500.

Amendment No. 2 added a 6% cost of living increase in the amount of \$4,500, which was approved by Council for Fiscal Year 2015-2016.

Amendment No. 1 exercised the first 12-month extension option beginning October 1, 2015 for \$75,000. The original 12-month agreement was approved by Council for \$75,000 beginning October 1, 2014.
