**ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** In 2017, the City of Austin and Eanes Independent School District agreed on the need for the design, installation, operation, and maintenance of the pedestrian hybrid beacon (PHB) at Walsh Tarlton Lane near Hill Country Middle School. Since the PHB was originally funded from the Capital Metro Quarter Cent Fund, the City proceeded with the construction of the PHB to meet the scheduled commitments associated with this fund, putting it into operation in October 2017. Installation of the PHB improved pedestrian access and safety for students and staff at Hill Country Middle school, and transit users and pedestrians in the area. Since the PHB is located within the City's full-purpose jurisdiction, it is currently being operated and maintained by the City. The District will refund the City
