ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This budget amendment appropriates grant funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). This amendment asks for the approval of \$2,749,847 in grant funds. Of these grant funds, \$2,643,247 represents the operating component whilst the remaining \$106,600 is captured in the capital budget. Council will be presented with additional appropriation requests in the future once FEMA has approved the projects and determined funding estimates accordingly. The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant.
