3	WHEREAS, the City allocates 15 percent of the funds received from the hotel
4	occupancy tax to the Cultural Arts Fund for the encouragement, promotion,
5	improvement, and application of the arts, including instrumental and vocal music,
6	dance, drama, folk art, creative writing, architecture, design and applied fields, painting,
7	sculpture, photography, graphic and creative arts, motion pictures, radio, television,
8	tape and sound recording and other arts related to the presentation, performance,
9	execution and exhibition of a major art form; and
10	WHEREAS, the City, through its Economic Development Department, Cultural
11	Arts Division, serves to encourage, develop, and facilitate an enriched environment of
12	artistic, creative, and cultural activity in the City; and
13	WHEREAS, the Cultural Arts Division manages the Cultural Arts Fund in
14	compliance with Chapter 351 of the Texas Tax Code, which authorizes funds to be spent
15	to encourage the promotion of tourism and the hotel and convention industry; and
16	WHEREAS, the City Arts Commission, along with the Cultural Arts Division,
17	developed a funding plan based on the model adopted by the City Council in Resolution

WHEREAS, the City and the Zachary Scott Theatre have entered into an operations agreement in which the City pays \$60,000 for maintenance, and it is sourced from the Cultural Arts Fund; and

22	WHEREAS, the City Council reaffirms its support of language in the agreements
23	for Zachary Scott Theatre regarding labor matters in the contract for the upcoming year;
24	NOW, THEREFORE,
25	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:
26	The City Council approves the award of contracts for cultural arts services for
27	Fiscal Year 2020-2021 to the contractors listed in the attached Exhibit "A" in the
28	corresponding amounts, subject to adjustment as set out below, in a total amount not to
29	exceed \$3,582,971 and authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and execute these
30	contracts with terms and conditions as may be favorable, necessary, or required; and
31	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The City Council authorizes payment in the
32	amount of \$60,000 for Zachary Scott Theatre for maintenance and operations, per a
33	separate, current operations agreement, to be paid from the Cultural Arts Fund, with the
34	additional direction to the City Manager that the labor peace language from the 2016-
35	2017 agreement be included in the new agreement, and that language also be added to
36	that agreement and in the award of the cultural arts grant to require return of funds paid
37	to Zachary Scott Theatre from the City in the event of a determination of violation of
38	labor law by a federal court of appeals with competent jurisdiction over the matter.
