Posting Language

Ratify an agreement with Austin Voices for Education and Youth to serve as an information and referral call center for High Risk Workers affected by COVID-19 in an amount not to exceed \$500,000 for the term ending on December 30, 2020.

Fiscal Note

Funding in the amount of \$500,000 is included in the COVID-19 Spending Framework (Resolution No. 20200604-040) as part of the Economic Support for Financial and Other Direct Support.

Prior Council Action:

May 21, 2020 - Council approved Resolution No. 20200521-038 directing the City Manager to establish a unified city strategy for high-risk workers, with an 11-0 vote on the virtual dais.

June 4, 2020 - Council approved Resolution No. 20200604-040 adopting the COVID-19 proposed spending framework for the use of all available federal and local funding that maximizes the benefit of federal COVID-19 relief funding and local funding, with an 11-0 vote on the virtual dais.
