13 **REDUCE EXPENDITURES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,699,615 AND INCREASE**
14 **THE TRANSFER IN BY \$728,385 TO THE AUSTIN TRANSPORTATION**
15 **DEPARTMENT MOBILITY FUND FROM THE AUSTIN TRANSPORTATION**
16 **DEPARTMENT PARKING MANAGEMENT FUND TO SUPPORT COVID-19**
17 **EMERGENCY RELIEF; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

20 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

23 **PART 1.** Council amends the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Austin Transportation Department
24 Mobility Fund Operating Budget (Ordinance No. 20200812-001) to transfer out and
25 appropriate \$3,700,000 in temporary use of right-of-way fee revenue, that represents the
26 rent received by the City for temporary rental of the City's right of way, to the General
27 Fund Emergency Reserve Fund for the Business Preservation Fund.

29 **PART 2.** Council amends the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Austin Transportation Department
30 Operating Budget (Ordinance No. 20200812-001) to reduce expenditures in the amount of
31 \$1,699,615 and increase the transfer in by \$728,385 to the Austin Transportation
32 Department Mobility Fund from the Austin Transportation Department Parking
33 Management Fund to support COVID-19 emergency relief.

PART 3. Council finds that the COVID-19 pandemic and related emergency declarations and orders constitute an emergency, a grave public necessity, and an unusual and unforeseen condition that could not, by reasonable diligence, have been included in the original budget for the current fiscal year. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
