# Council Committee, Board

During the January 13, 2020, regular meeting of the Animal Advisory Commission, commissioners passed a recommendation to revise the definition of "UNPROVOKED BITING" in Section 3-1-1(20).

# Additional Backup Information:

The proposed ordinance amendment would provide clarification to the definition of unprovoked biting that was added to City Code Section 3-1-1 by City Council in 2019. The additional language would designate that ordinary animal care, including feeding and placing a collar, leash or harness on a dog, and walking towards or addressing the dog or its owner, would not constitute provocation. A new definition of provocation is being added to more clearly highlight what constitutes provoking a dog to bite.

The recommendation was considered and approved by the Animal Advisory Commission at its January 13, 2020 meeting at the request of the Animal Services Office in relation to an incident that occurred after the passage of the October 2019 Code amendment. ASO supports this recommendation to amend the City Code.
