The Emergency Medical Services Department may offer discounted transport fees (ALS1, ALS2, BLS) under the following circumstances:

Financially Indigent: Financially indigent means an uninsured or underinsured person who is accepted for care with a discounted obligation to pay for the services rendered based on Charity Care Eligibility System. Services eligible under this procedure will be made available to the patient on a sliding fee scale, in accordance with financial need, as determined in reference to Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPG) in effect at

the time of the determination. To qualify an individual must:

Have a family income and family size as described by the Federal Poverty Levels:

Medically Indigent: Medically indigent means a patient whose ATCEMS bills, after payment by third-party payers, exceeds a specified percentage of the person's Yearly Income, and who is unable to pay the remaining bill. A medically indigent patient will receive a 50% discount on the qualifying service. To qualify an individual must have:

Healthcare insurance

ATCEMS bills exceeding ten percent (10%) of the patient/s Adjusted Gross Income

A family income less than or equal to 500 percent of the Federal Poverty Guidelines
