ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This ordinance will accept \$300,000 in additional grant funding from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance for the Austin City Intellectua Property Crime Enforcement Project (October 1, 2020 - September 30, 2022). The Austin Police Department's (APD FY 2020-2021 budget includes \$100,000 in grant funds for this project and this action will accept an additiona \$300,000 in grant funds, bringing the total grant award to \$400,000. This grant-funded program will focus or criminal investigation, prosecution, prevention, and education as each relate to intellectual property enforcement The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant When the grant funds expire, the Austin Police Department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
