Additional Backup Information:

The contract will provide voltage recorders that produce real time data to troubleshoot customer service interruptions. The new model of voltage recorders has wireless features that will allow Austin Energy field employees to access power quality data from laptops reducing their exposure to electrical hazards and the need to attach recorders at the customer's service point. These recorders will replace 20-year-old equipment and allow Austin Energy to measure and record single phase, three-phase, and industrial voltage.

Austin Energy utilizes Power Monitor Inc.'s equipment, and its personnel are trained in the installation of the Power Monitor recorders and the operation of its software platform. Power Monitor Inc.'s equipment and software are not compatible with other brands and are available through direct factory sales only.
