

M/WBE Summary

Public notice was given for this solicitation CLMC823 Street Rehabilitation Phase 2 IDIQ Project No. 2, through the City's Vendor Connection web portal. Six bids were received and opened on December 10, 2020. Of the six bids received, four bids were from MBE/WBE certified firms. Alpha Paving Industries LLC submitted the lowest responsive bid:
