SPECIAL CALLED MEETING TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2021

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a special called joint meeting with the Travis County Commissioners Court on Tuesday, February 2, 2021 via Videoconference.

Mayor Adler called the Council Meeting to order at 9:04 a.m.

 Update on Covid-19 related matters.
Presentation was made by Dr. Mark Escott, Interim Medical Director and Stephanie Hayden-Howard, Director, Austin Public Health Department.

Direction to staff to analyze options for implementing enhancements such as an automated notification system for notifying residents on appointments; provide information provided by 311 in other languages; confirm with the City of San Antonio on the extra vaccines received for home-bound residents announced today; provide contact information for specific issues such as website challenges, submitting names of residents who do not have computer access, feedback on 311; where retail and restaurant employees factor into the distribution timeline; and provide information on outreach and accommodations being make for hearing/visually impaired residents.

Mayor Adler adjourned the Council Meeting at 11:20 a.m. without objection.
