Approve an ordinance authorizing acceptance of \$30,000 in grant funds from the Texas Historical Commission's Certified Local Government grant program and amending the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Housing and Planning Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund (Ordinance No. 20200812-001) to appropriate \$30,000 for phase 1 of an equity-focused historic preservation plan.

Funding in the amount of \$30,000 is available from the Texas Historical Commission's Certified Local Government grant program. A City funding match is not required. A fiscal note is attached.

Additional Backup Information:

The Certified Local Government grant provides funds to participating municipal governments to develop and sustain an effective historic preservation program. The grant is considered one-time funding with an allocation period of 19 months, from March 26, 2021 through October 31, 2022.

The historic preservation plan (phase 1, 2021-22) seeks to replace Austin's 1981 preservation plan with an inclusive, equity-focused, and community-based planning process and outcome. Phase 1 will result in a draft historic preservation plan, including recommended policies, tools, and programmatic changes.

Grant funds will be matched by time committed by existing City staff and community stakeholders.
