The Community Development Commission meeting to be held **April 13, 2021** with Social Distancing Modifications.

Public comment will be allowed via telephone; no in-person input will be allowed. **All speakers must register in advance (April 12, 2021 by noon)**. All public comment will occur at the beginning of the meeting.

To speak remotely at the April 13, 2021 Community Development Commission meeting, residents must:

- Call or email the board liaison at 512-974-1606 or jesse.gutierrez@austintexas.gov no later than noon, April 12, 2021. The following information required: speaker name, item number(s) they wish to speak on, whether they are for/against/neutral, email address and telephone number (must be the same number that will be used to call into the meeting).
- Once a request to speak has been made to the board liaison, the information to call on the day of the scheduled meeting will be provided either by email or phone call.
- Speakers must call in at least 15 minutes prior to meeting start in order to speak, late callers will not be accepted and will not be able to speak.
- Speakers will be placed in a queue until their time to speak.
- Handouts or other information may be emailed to jesse.gutierrez@austintexas.gov by noon the day before the scheduled meeting. This information will be provided to Board and Commission members in advance of the meeting.
