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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 2. On March 4, 2021, CenterPoint Energy Resources Corp., d/b/a CenterPoint Energy Entex and CenterPoint Energy Texas Gas, South Texas Division (CenterPoint) filed a proposed interim rate adjustment under the Gas Reliability Infrastructure Program (GRIP) with the City of Austin, Texas and the other cities that CenterPoint serves in its South Texas Division. The proposal would allow CenterPoint an interim rate increase to customers in its South Texas Division by \$44,723,636 in order to recover its incremental investment in the division made between January 1, 2020 and December 31, 2020.

PART 4. Pursuant to Texas Utilities Code § 104.301, the City is authorized to suspend the implementation of the interim rate adjustment for a period not to exceed 45 days beyond the effective date proposed by CenterPoint.

PART 6. The implementation of the interim rate adjustment in CenterPoint’s GRIP filing proposed to take effect on May 3, 2021 is hereby suspended until the sooner of (a) the 45th day from the proposed effective date, or (b) the date acted upon by the City Council.
