


### COVID-19 Progress Towards Herd Immunity Austin - Travis County












# Filtered Moving Average of Admissions

### Filtered Moving Average: 13.85




#### COVID-19 AUSTIN MSA CURRENT HOSPITALIZATIONS, ICU ADMISSIONS, AND VENTILATOR USE





#### City of Austin - Travis County COVID-19 Count of Weekly Hospitalizations by Age Group (Austin MSA)







#### City of Austin - Travis County COVID-19 Count of Weekly Hospitalizations by Race/Ethnicity (Austin MSA)



#### Percent Positive by Test Collection Week and Year - Last 12 Weeks





- 7 Hospitalizations (All age >50)
- 2 Deaths (All age >70)

#### • Reinfection (under investigation)

- 362 potential reinfections (0.43%)
- 44 Hospitalizations
- 4 Deaths




DSHS Vaccine Report in Travis County by age

## Age 12 +

- 63.56% vaccinated with at least one dose
- 50.95% FULLY vaccinated
- 12-15 years: 13,308

# Age 65 +

- 85% vaccinated with at least one dose
- 73% FULLY vaccinated
