SUBJECT: Update on Resolution 20210401-005 Department Reintegration Plans

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide an update on the request for department reintegration plans per Resolution 20210401-005.

Each City of Austin department has created a phased-in reintegration plan that meets its business needs. Reintegration plans include information on teleworking guidelines, sanitation and safety protocols, personal protective equipment, and signage and communication for employees. As we are still in an active pandemic response and situations can change rapidly, the reintegration plans may need to be updated or changed in order to meet the needs of employees and the community. Below is a brief description of the phases for reintegration, although each department-specific plan may vary:

Phase 1 Integration: Phase 1 begins the initial steps to reintegrate back into the workplace.

Phase 2 Integration: Phase 2 builds upon phase one and encourages more employees to begin returning to the workplace. Departments will identify employees whose job functions require them to be on-site part of the time.

Phase 3 Integration: Phase 3 will include reintegrating the remaining employees back into the workplace. Employees may continue to telework, work on-site, or a blend of both, depending on department-specific business needs.

There are over 5,400 non-sworn employees and over 3,300 sworn employees who have reported to work on-site throughout the pandemic. More will be returning over the next couple of months as 14 departments will begin reintegrating an additional 1,900 employees in June. Attached is a summary of the reintegration plans for the departments by phases.

Providing vaccinations for employees is critical for the safety and wellness of our employees, which is always our first priority. Information and resources, such as the following, have been provided to all City employees.
