7	November of 2020; and,
8	WHEREAS, Council directed the City Manager to include certain
9	provisions in a draft Joint Powers Agreement, to be reviewed and approved by City
10	Council; and,
11	WHEREAS, Council directed the City Manager to include in the Joint
12	Powers Agreement a procedure to transfer the Project Connect Tax Revenue in a
13	proportionate amount on an annual and more frequent basis until the debt is paid
14	off and the funds are no longer required for operations, maintenance, or a state of
15	good repair; and,
16	WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Austin Transit Partnership have
17	developed the procedure, and are bringing it forward at this time for Council
18	approval in the form of an Interlocal Agreement Between City of Austin and
19	Austin Transit Partnership for Terms of Joint Powers Agreement on Transfer of
20	"November 2020 Proposition A" Property Tax Revenue; and,
21	WHEREAS, Council has reviewed the procedure and desires the City
22	Manager to implement this process; NOW, THEREFORE,
