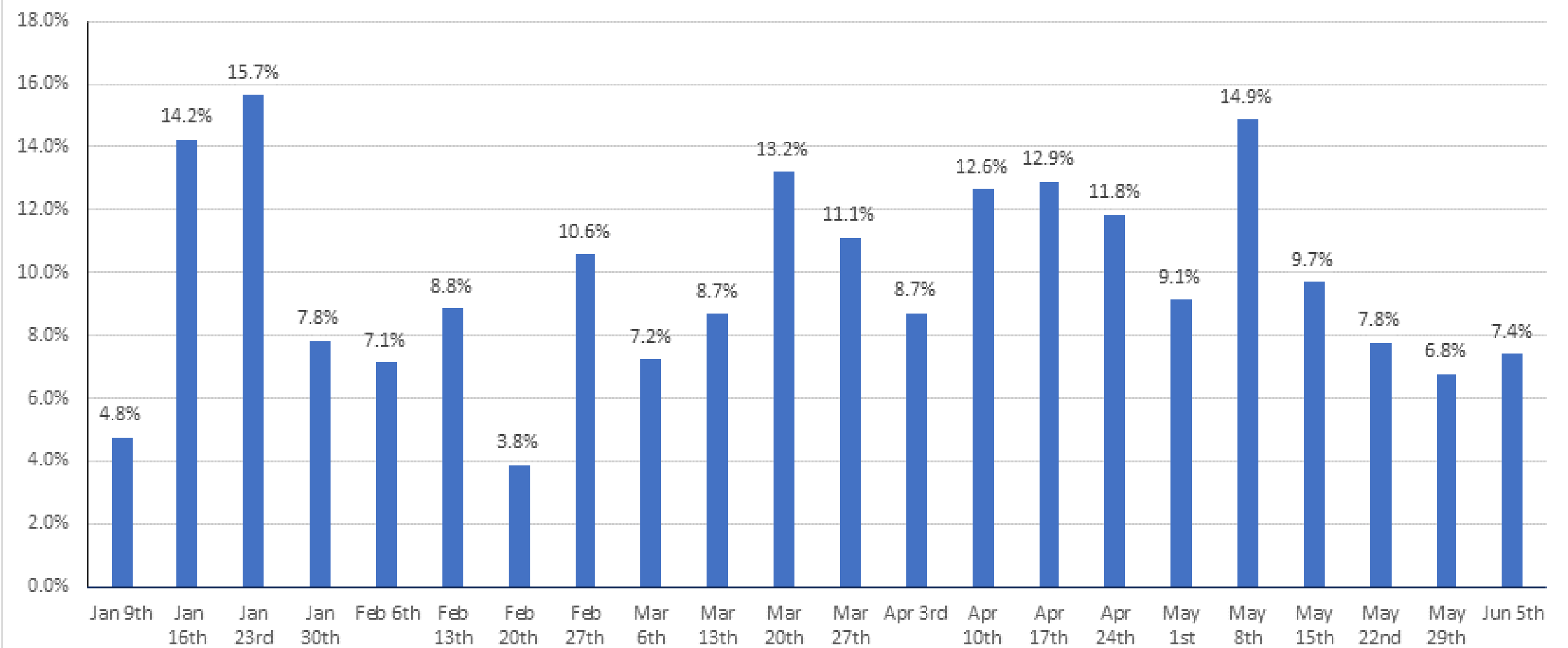

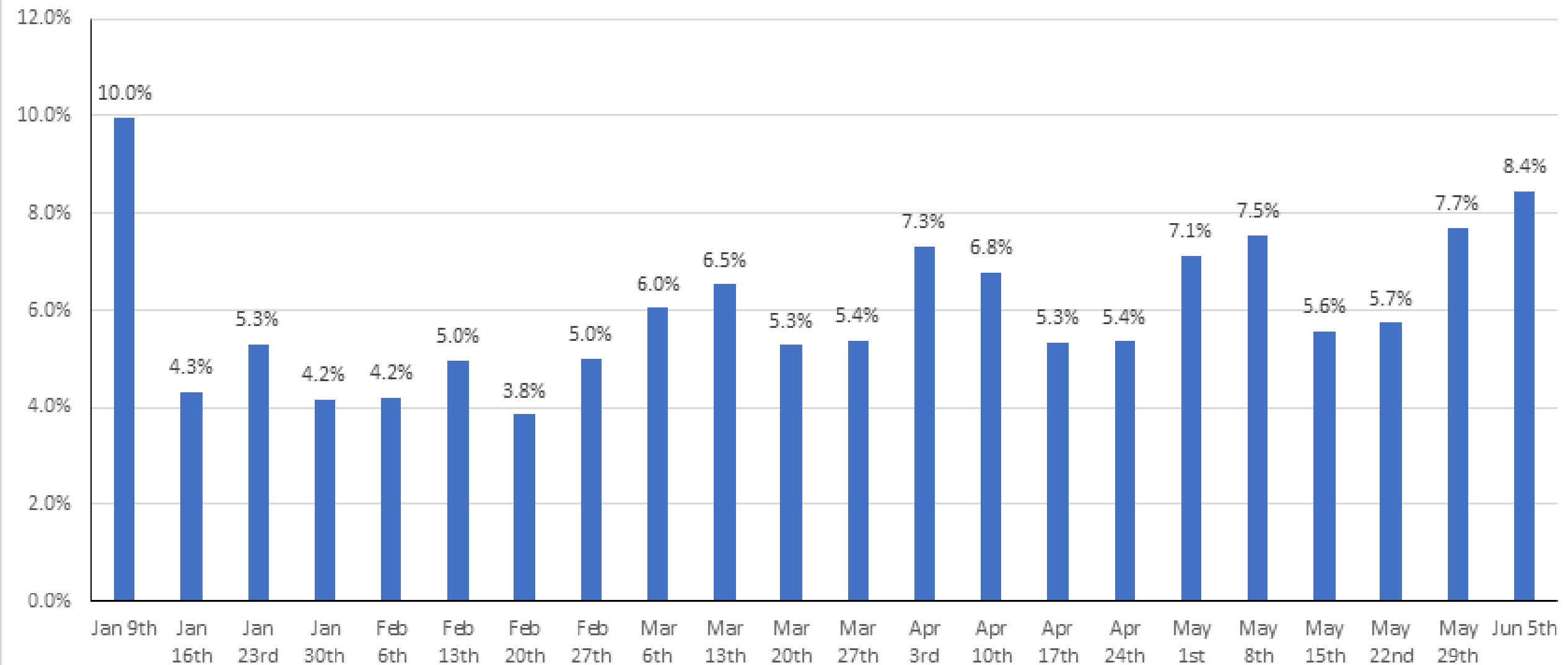

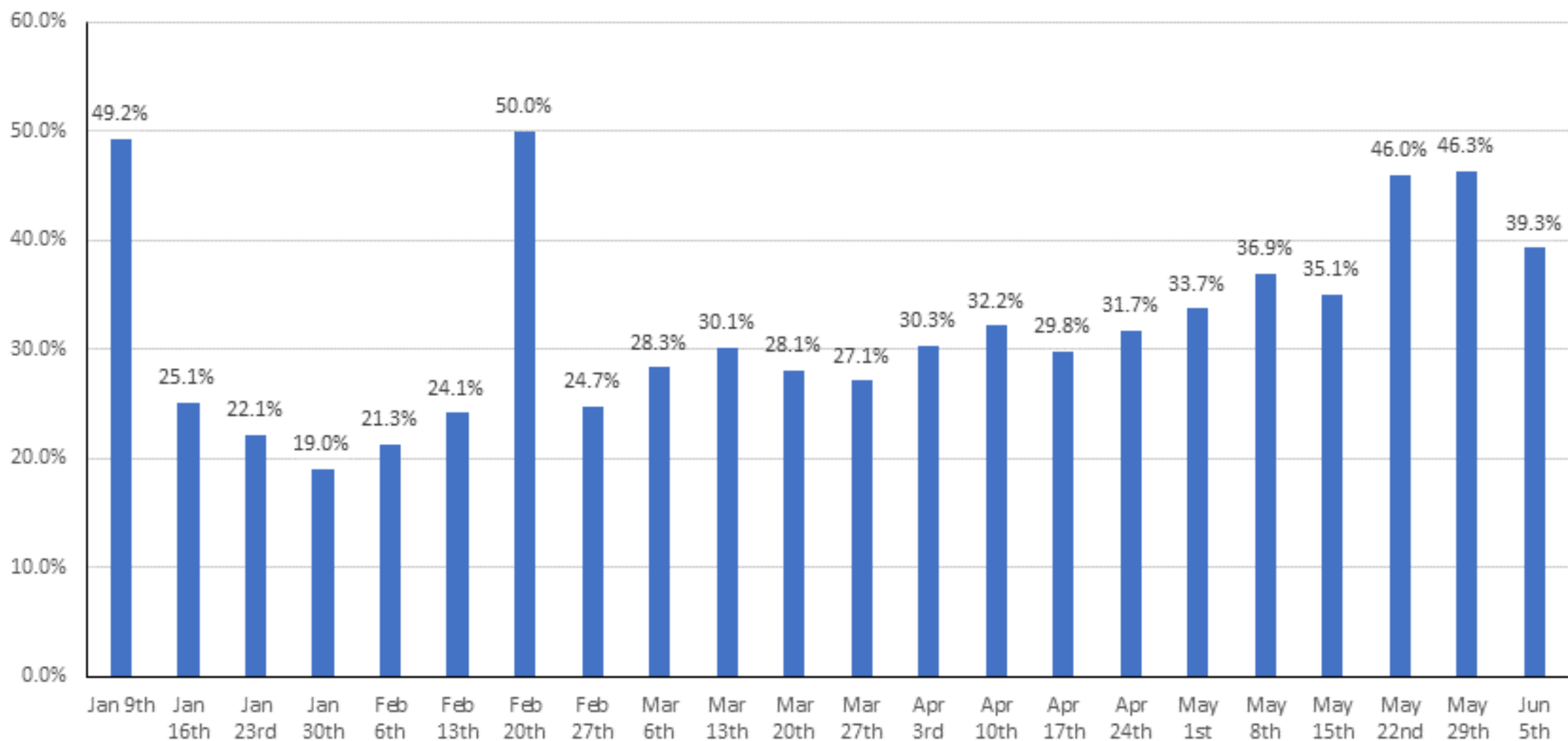
# Percentage of COVID-19 Vaccination Administered to **Asians** by Week of Clinic, Austin Public Health, 2021



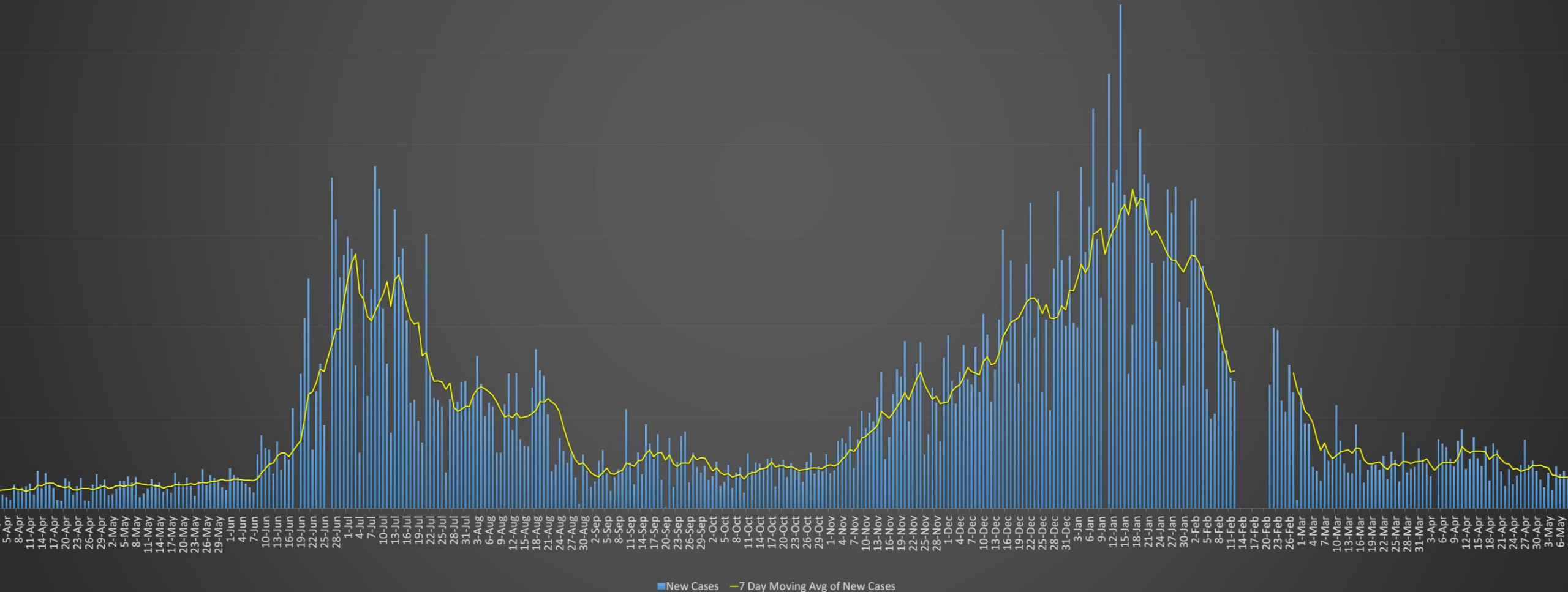
# Percentage of COVID-19 Vaccination Administered to **Blacks** by Week of Clinic, Austin Public Health, 2021



# Percentage of COVID-19 Vaccinations Administered to **Hispanics** by Week of Clinic, Austin Public Health, 2021

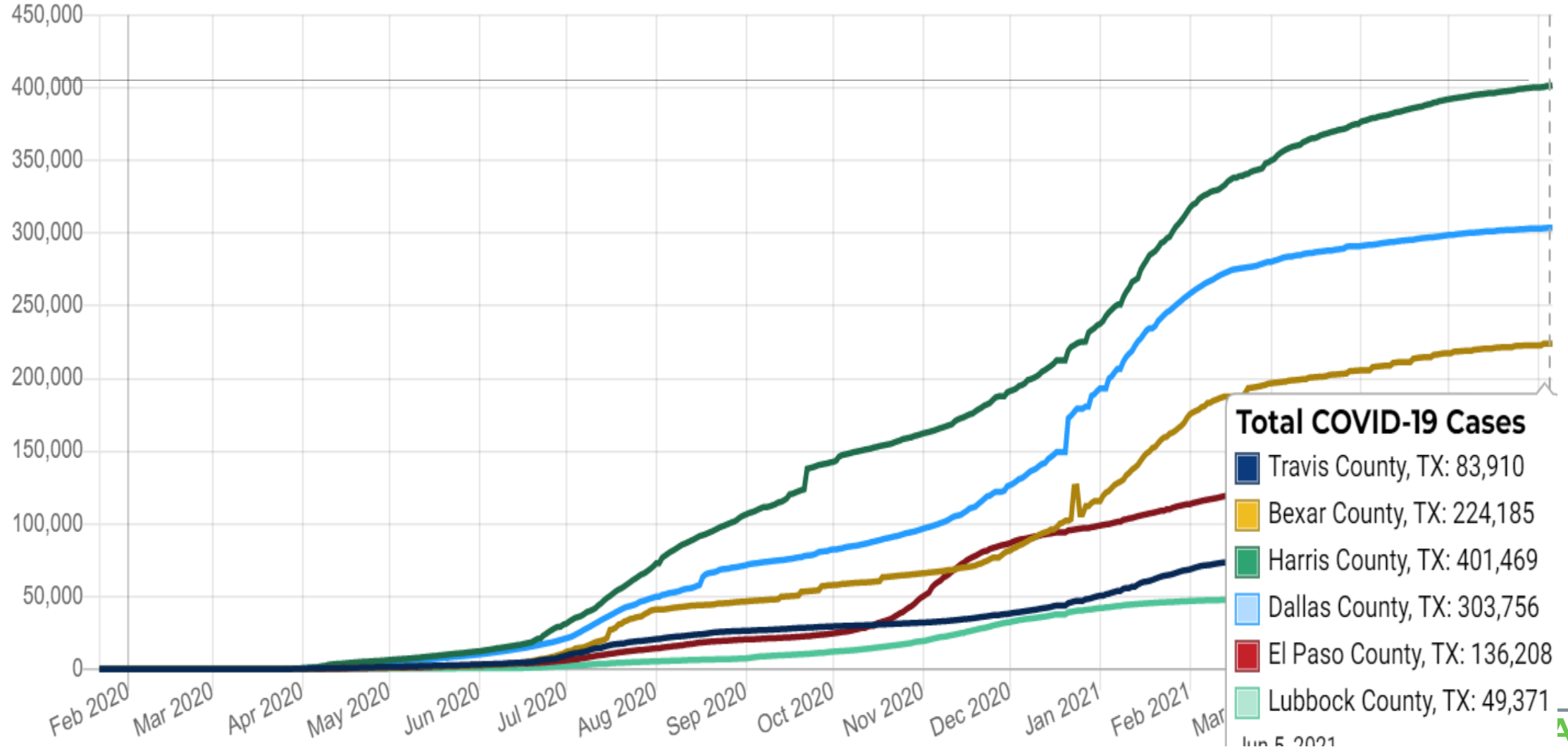

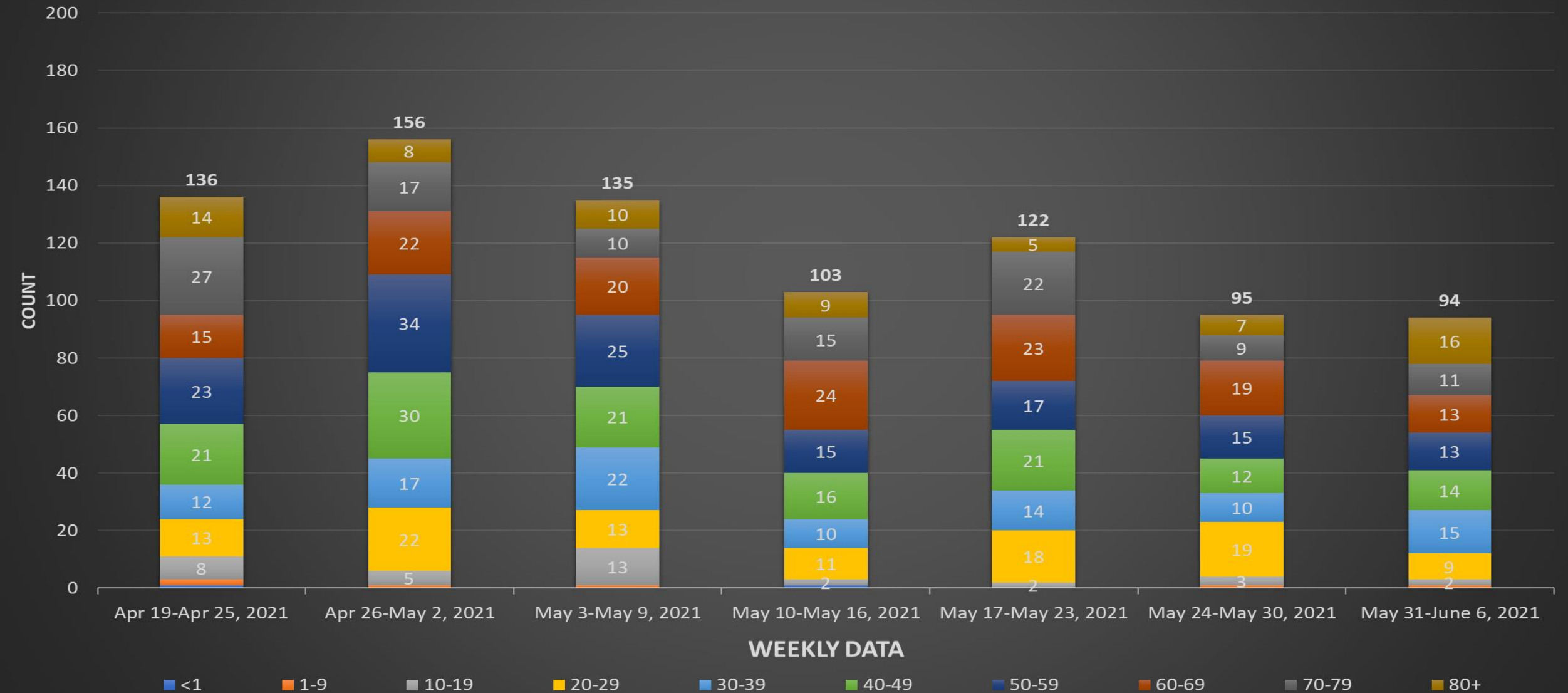

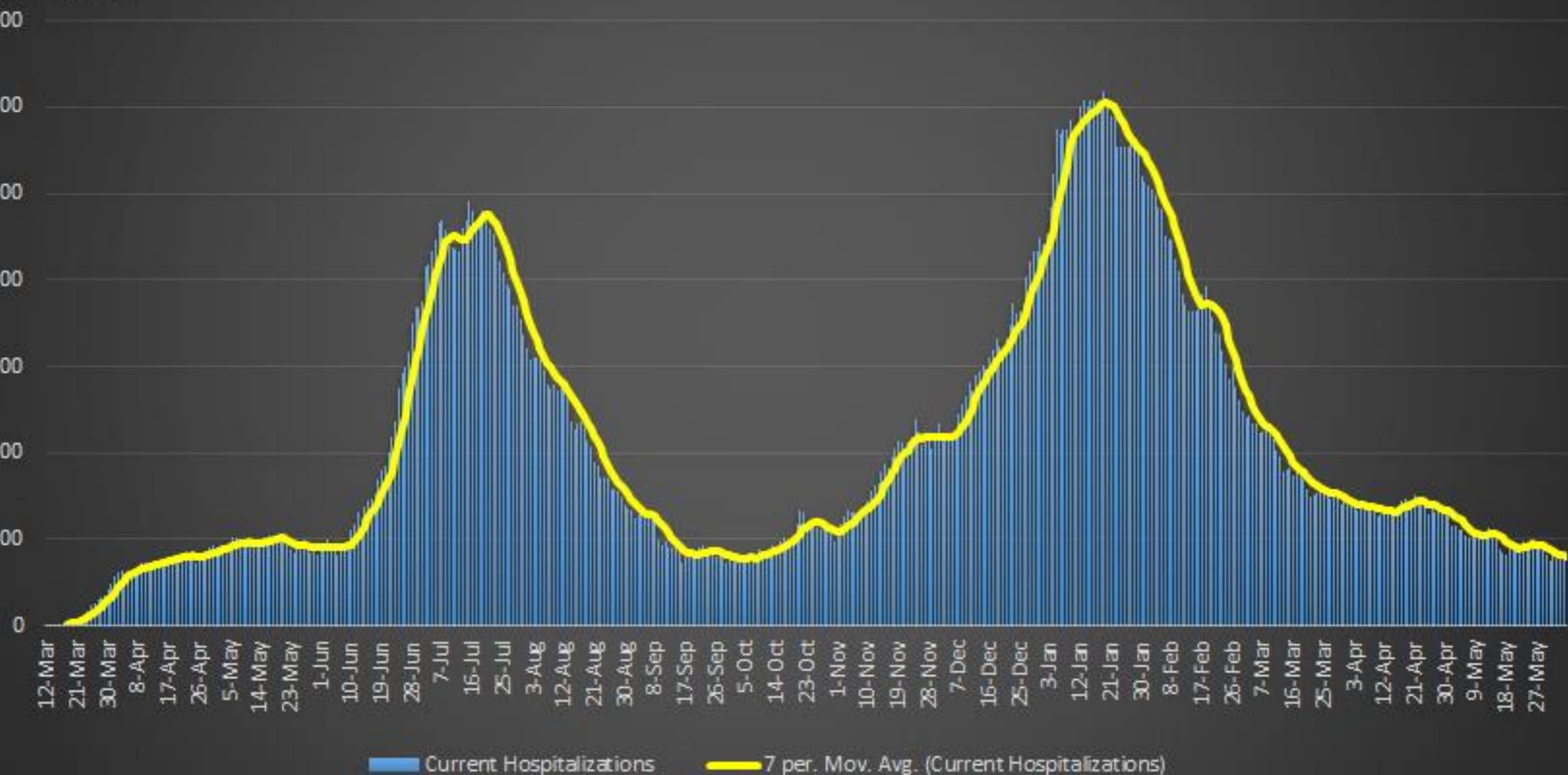

# City of Austin - Travis County COVID-19 Count of Weekly Hospitalizations by Age Group (Austin MSA)



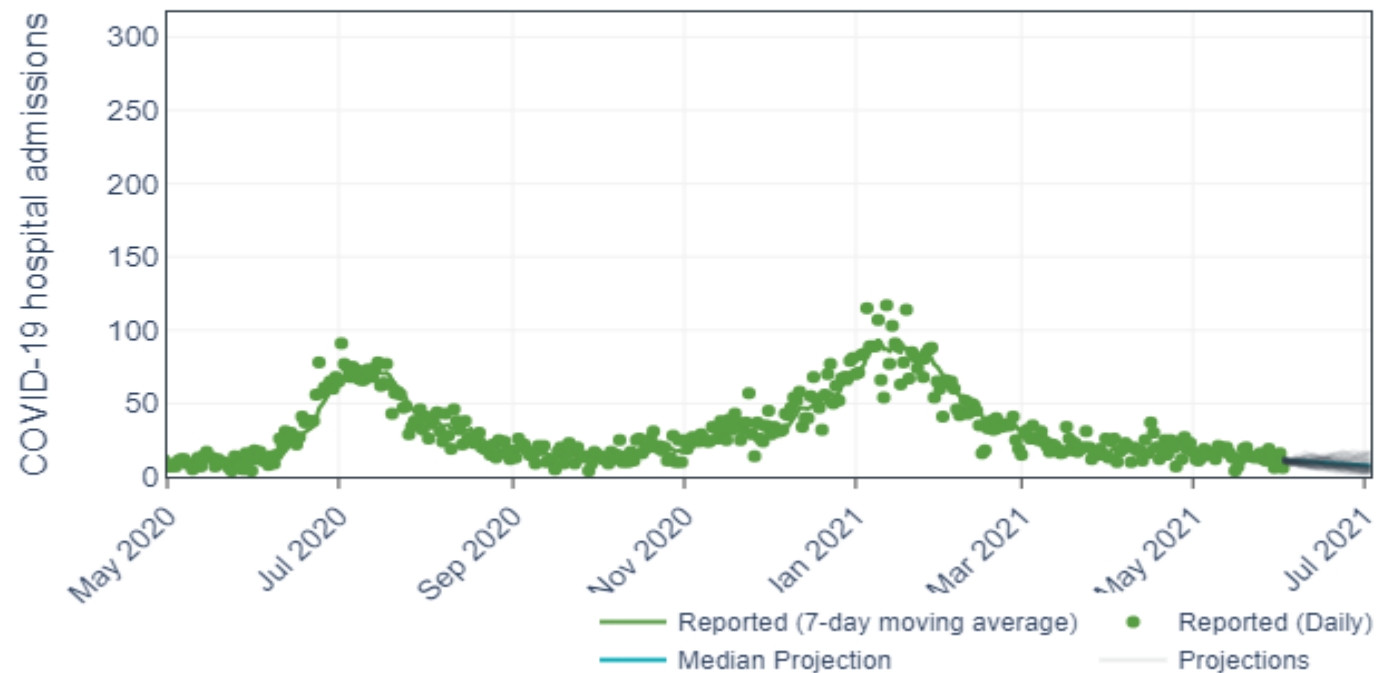
## COVID-19 Austin MSA Current Hospitalizations



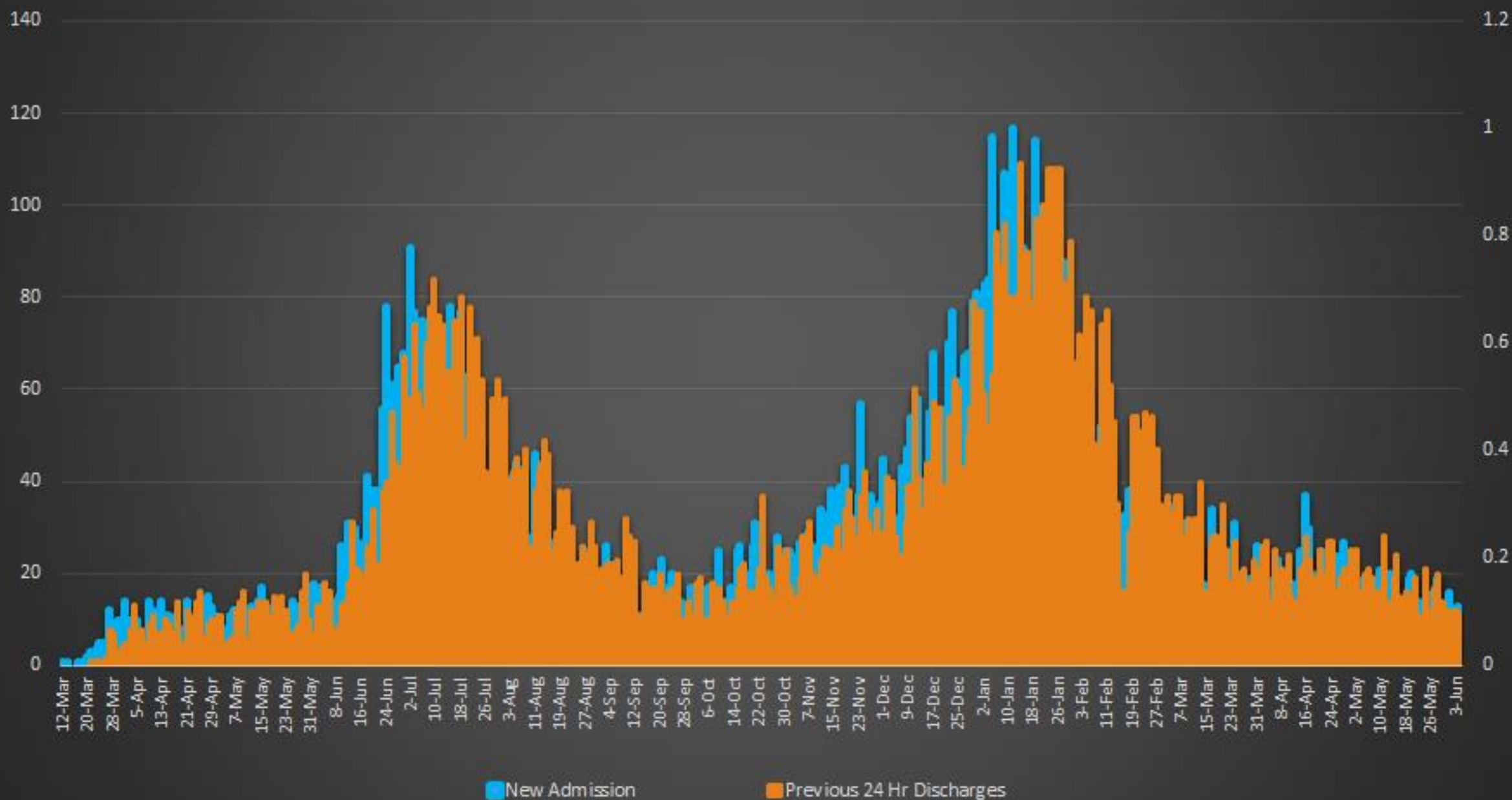


# COVID-19 Hospitalization Projections

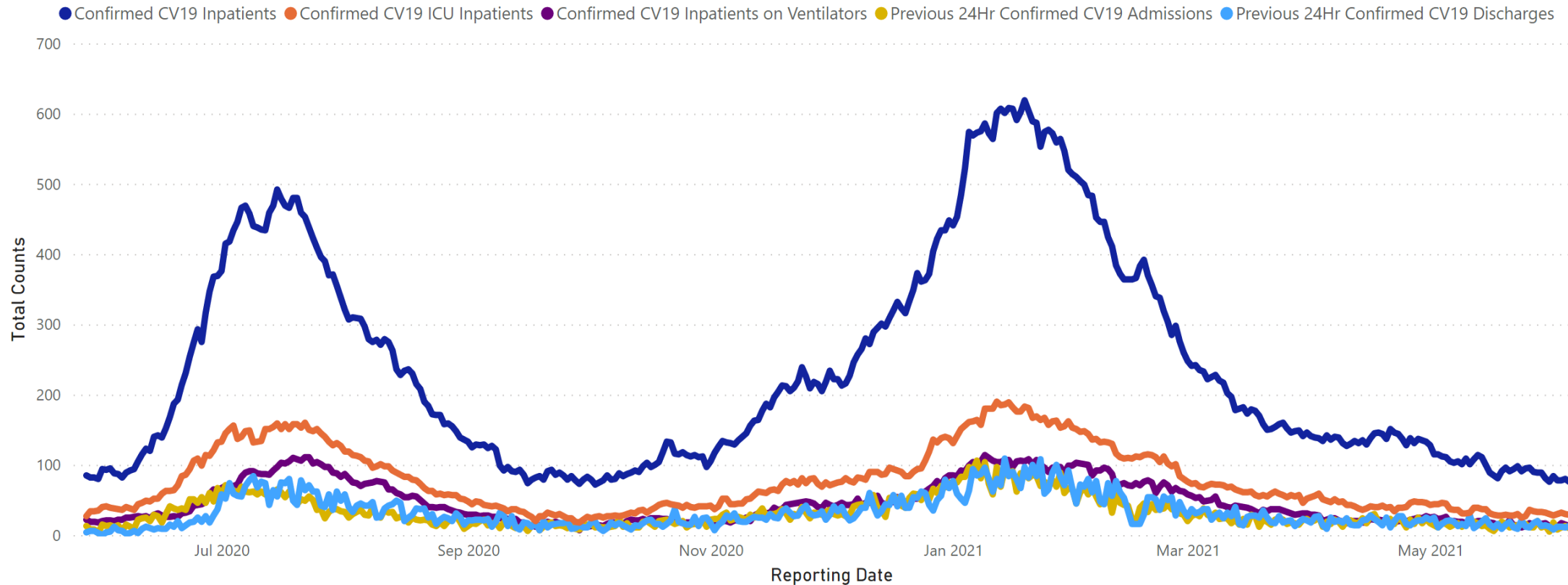

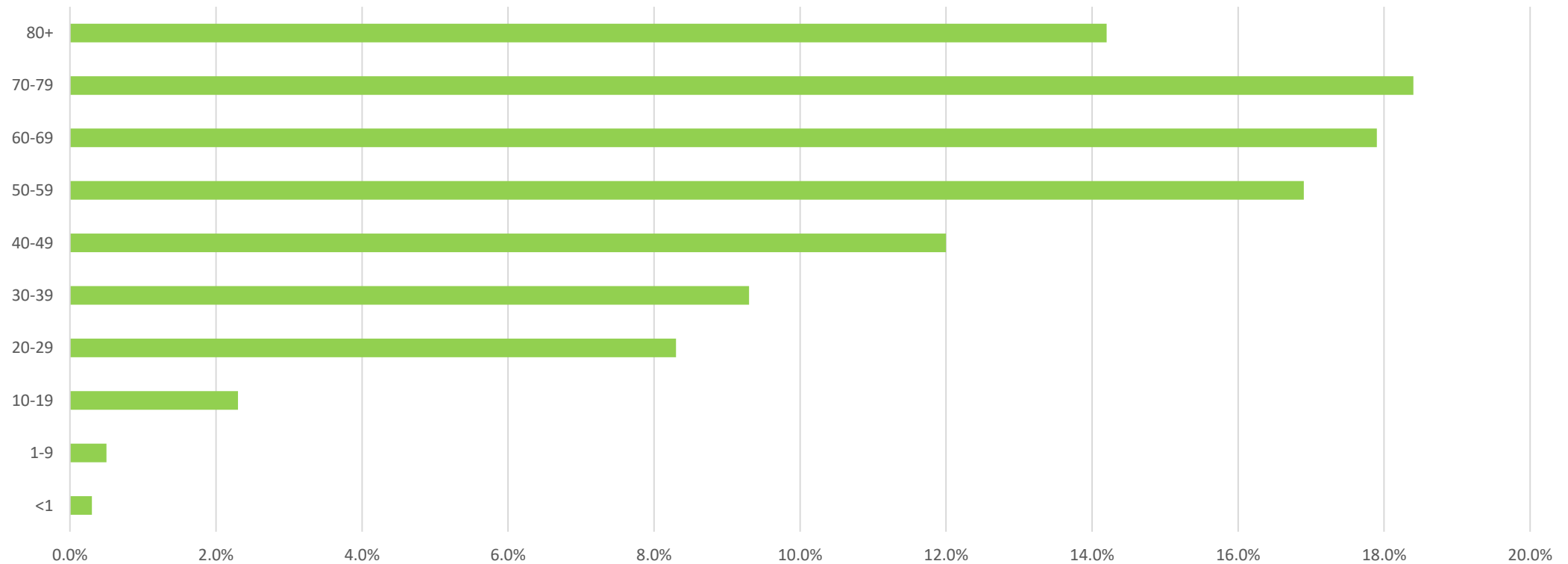

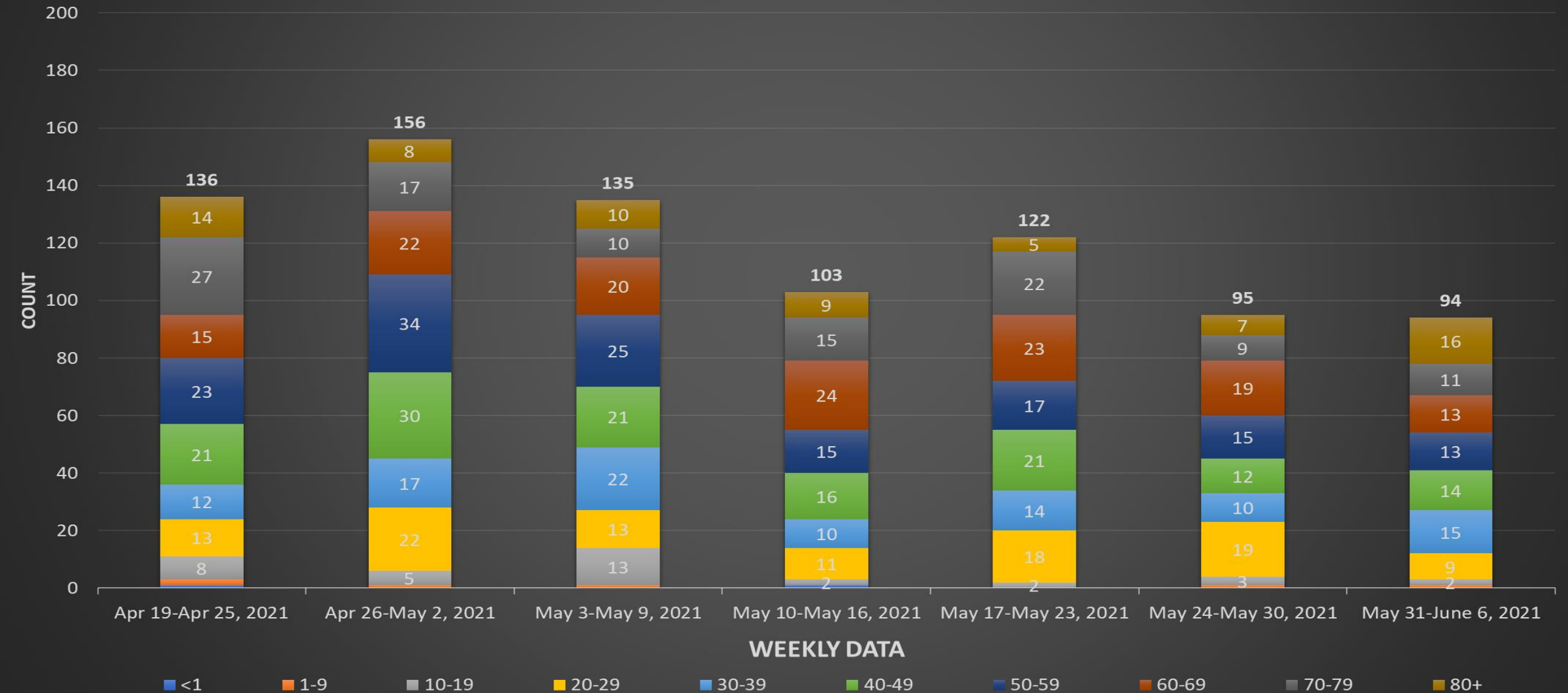


# Hospitalizations as of 5/30/21

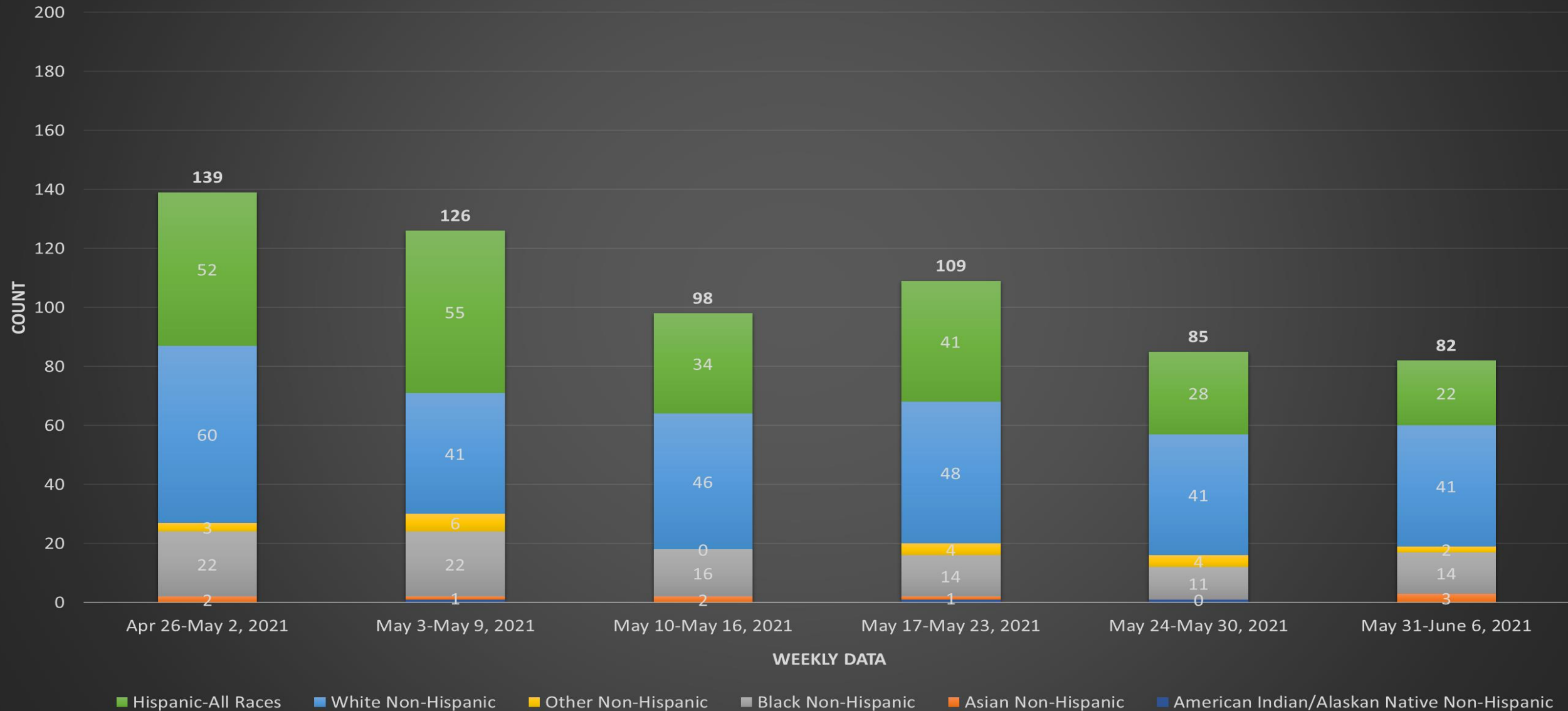

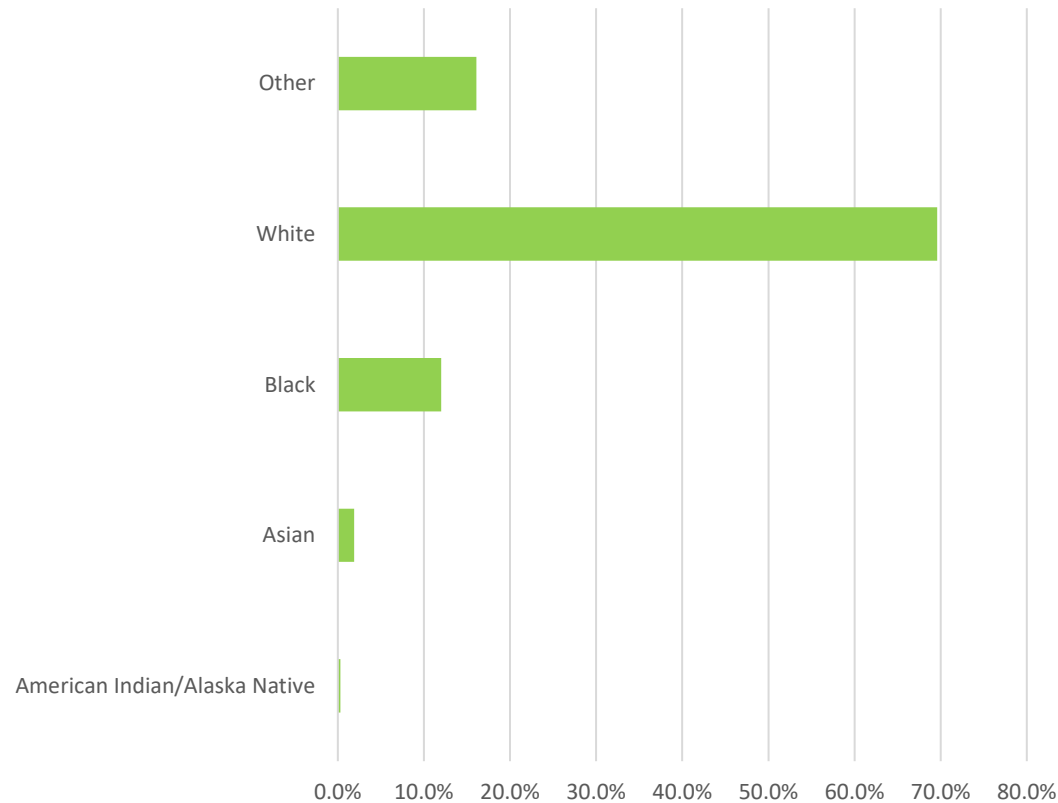

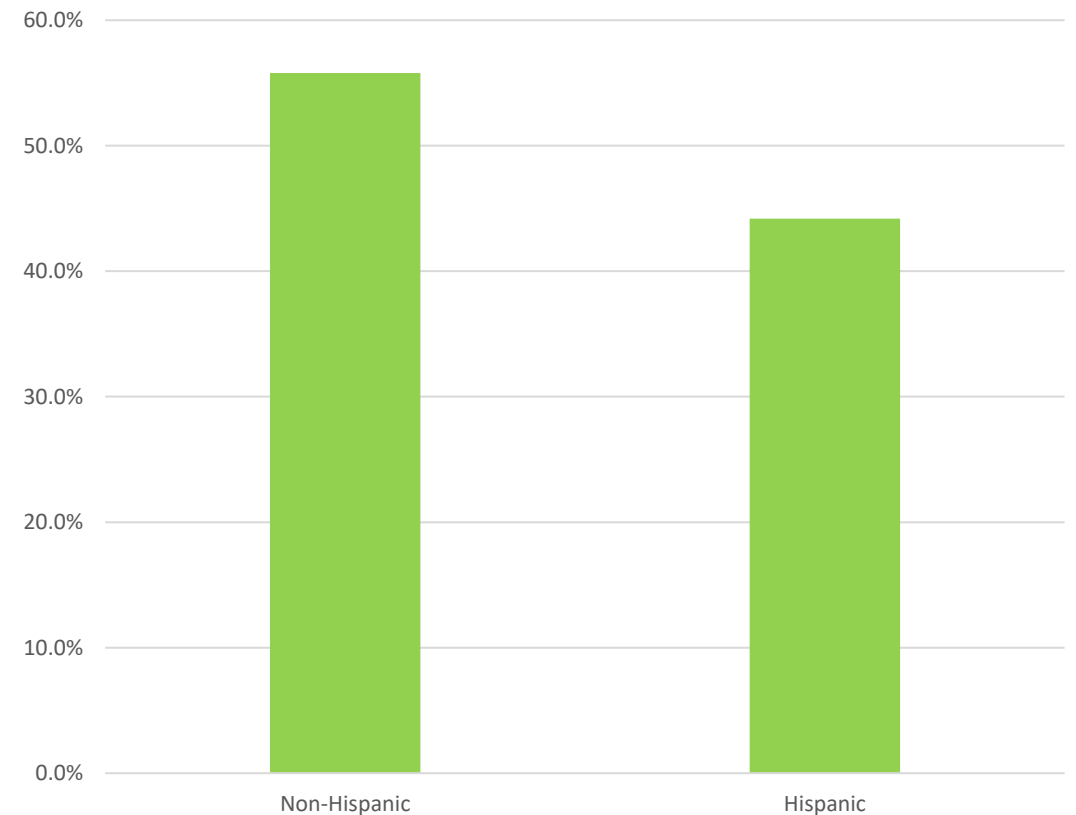

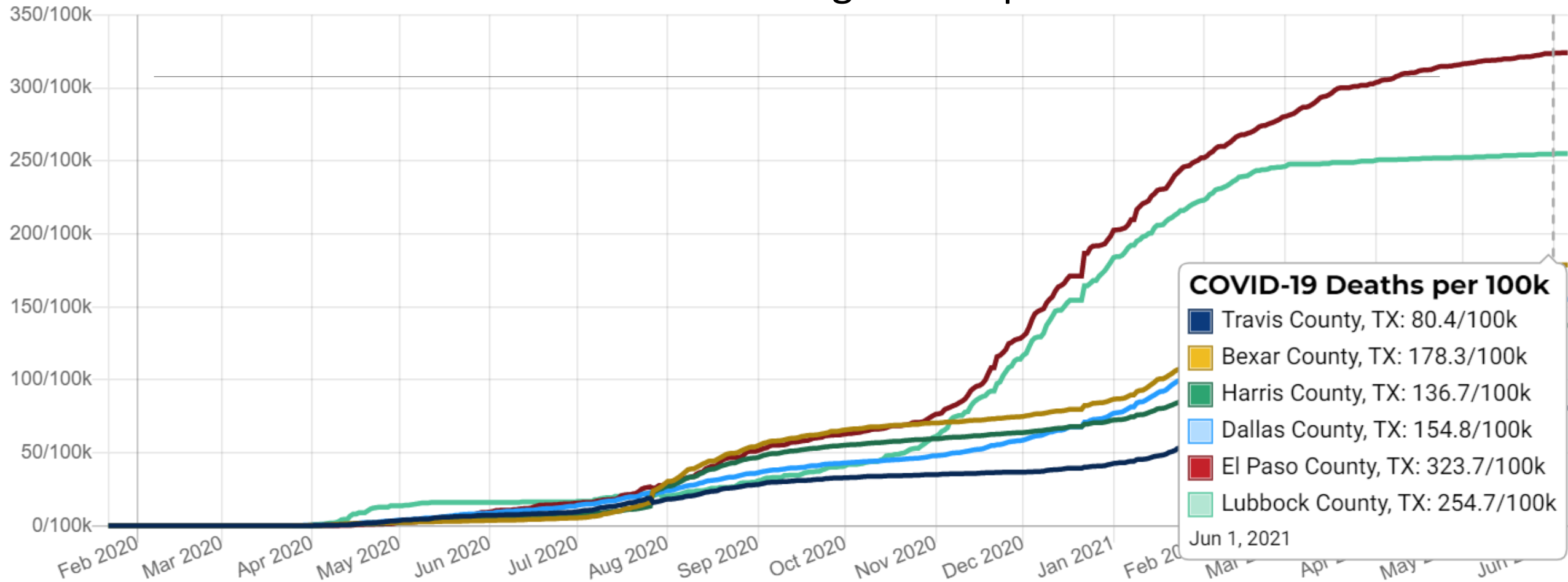

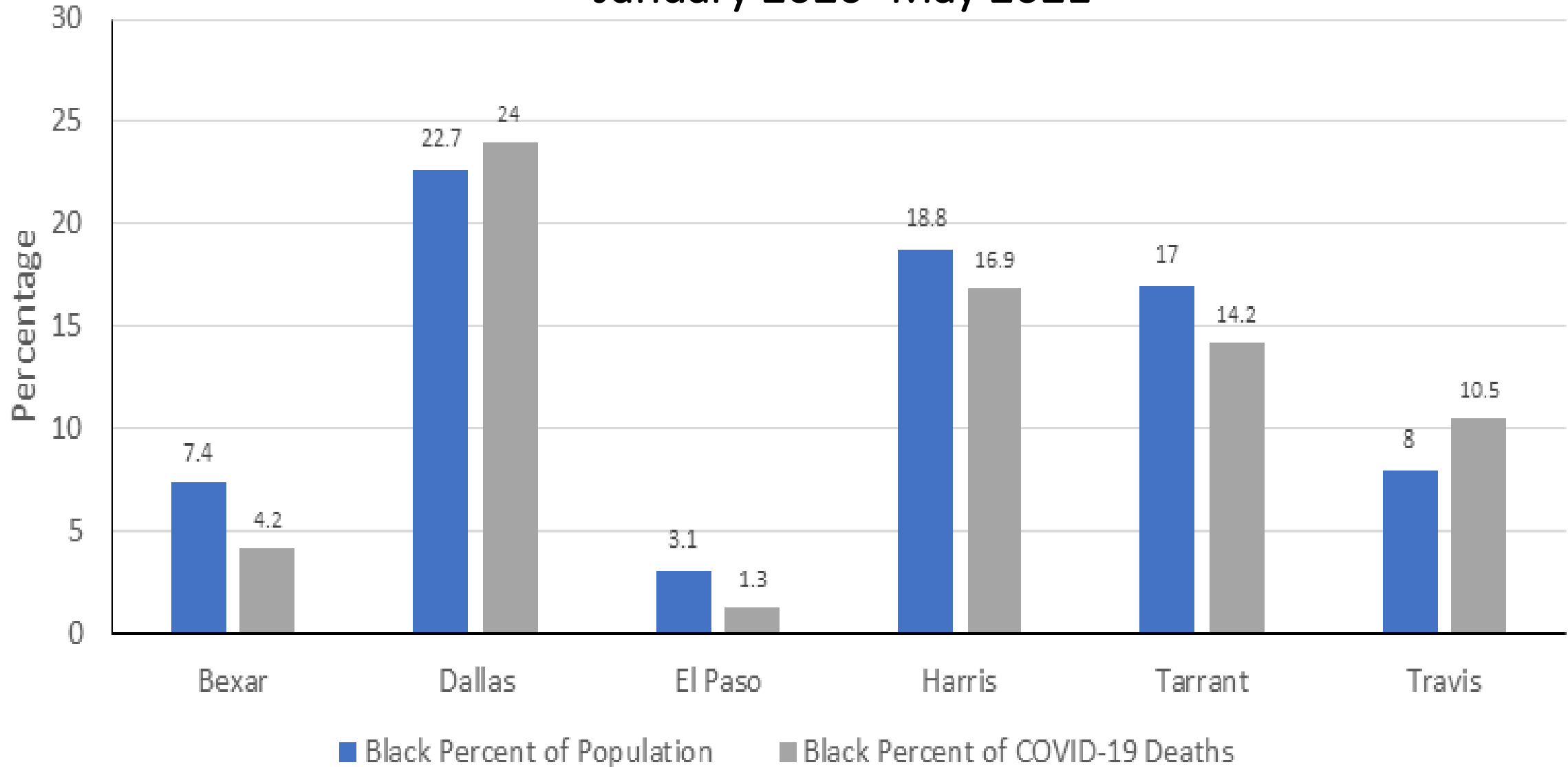

Between Counties with Large Metropolitan Areas



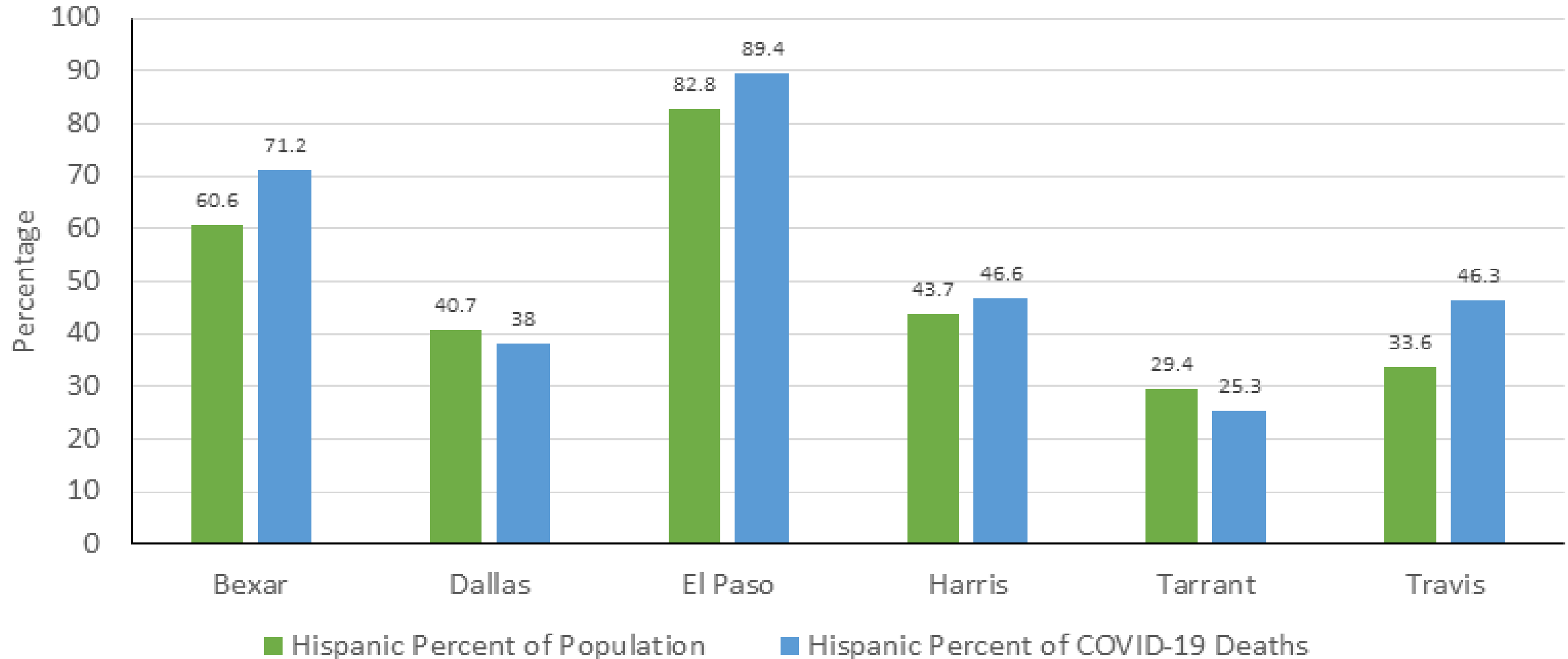
# Percentage of Blacks by County Population and COVID -19 Deaths

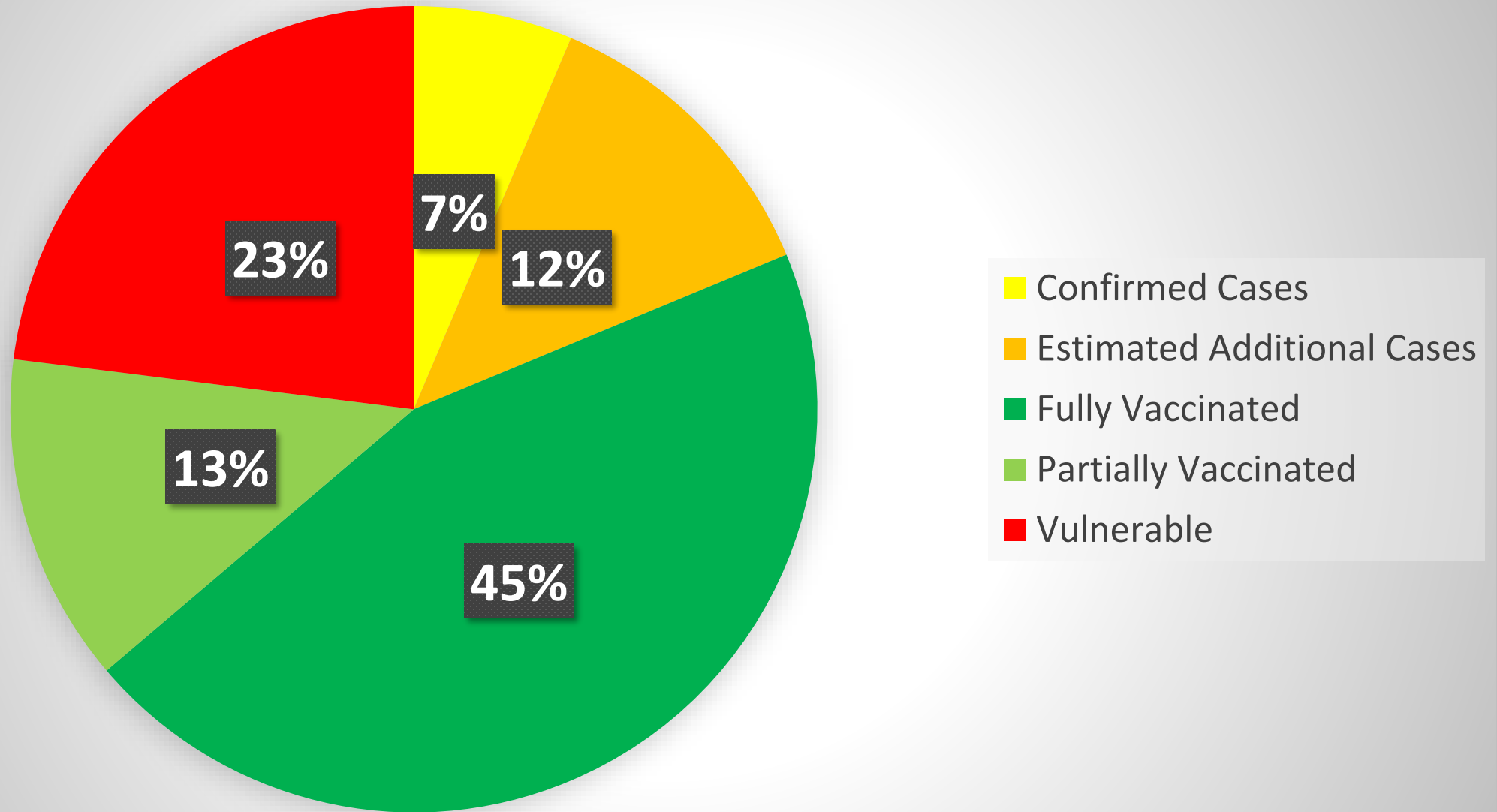

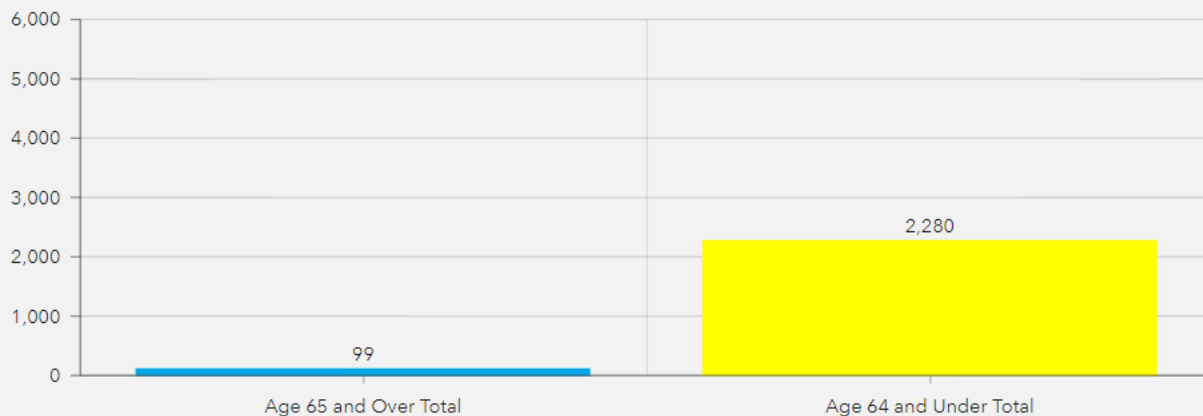

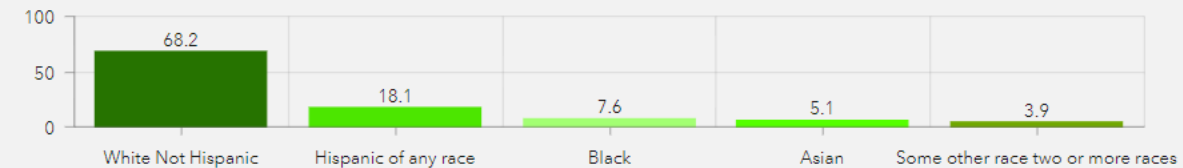

Percentage of Persons 65 years of age or older, Travis County, Texas



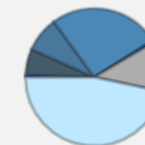

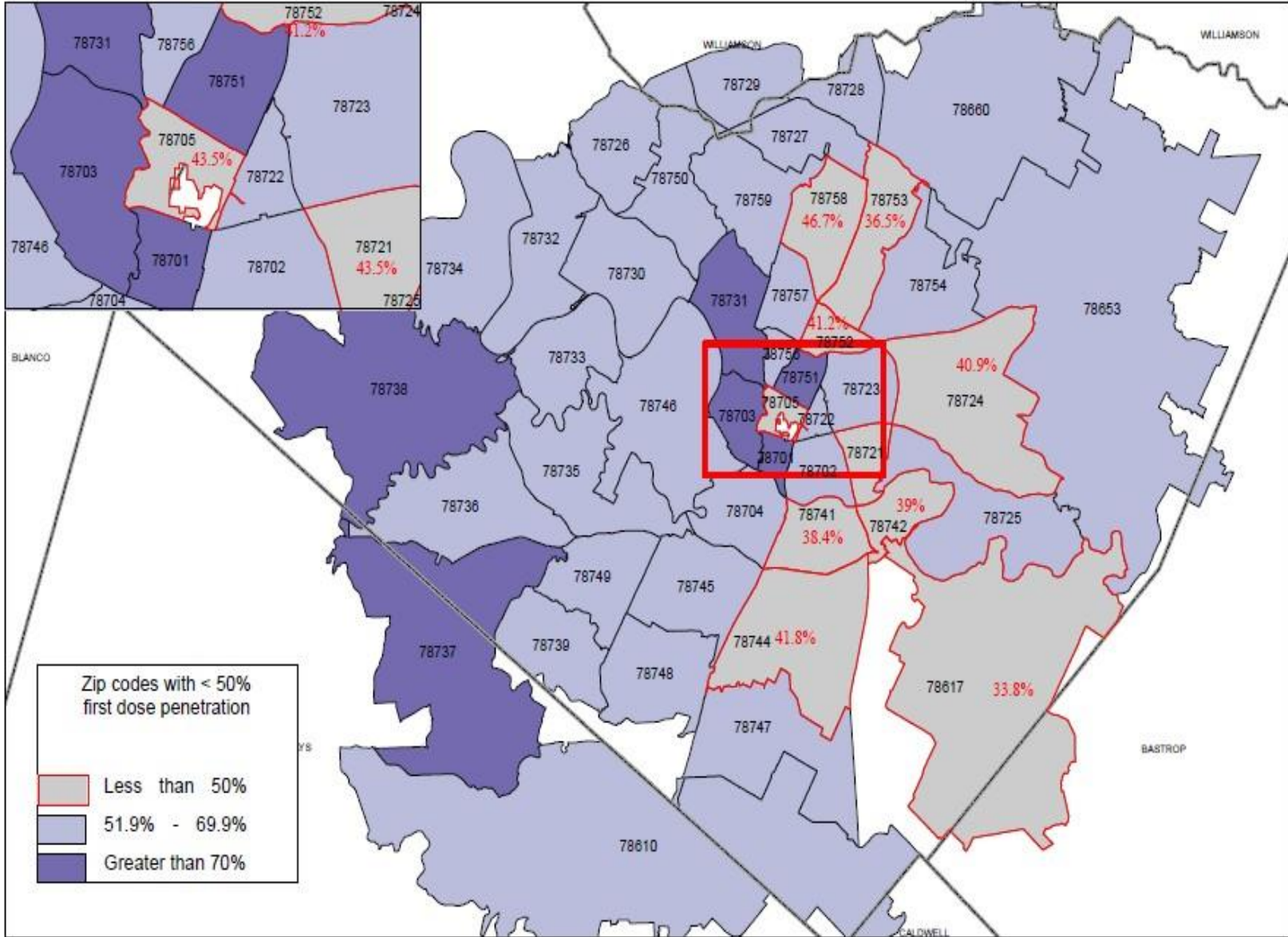

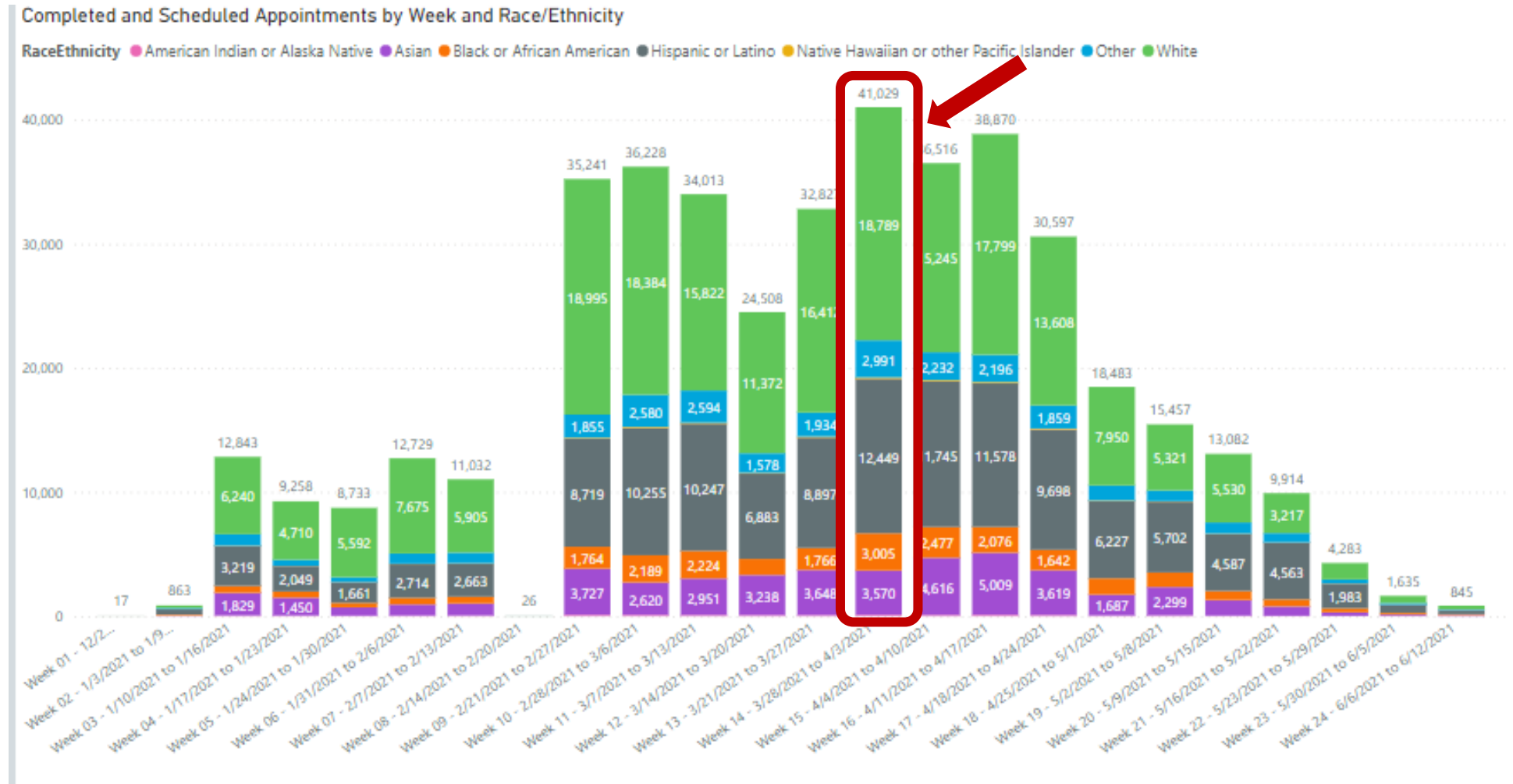

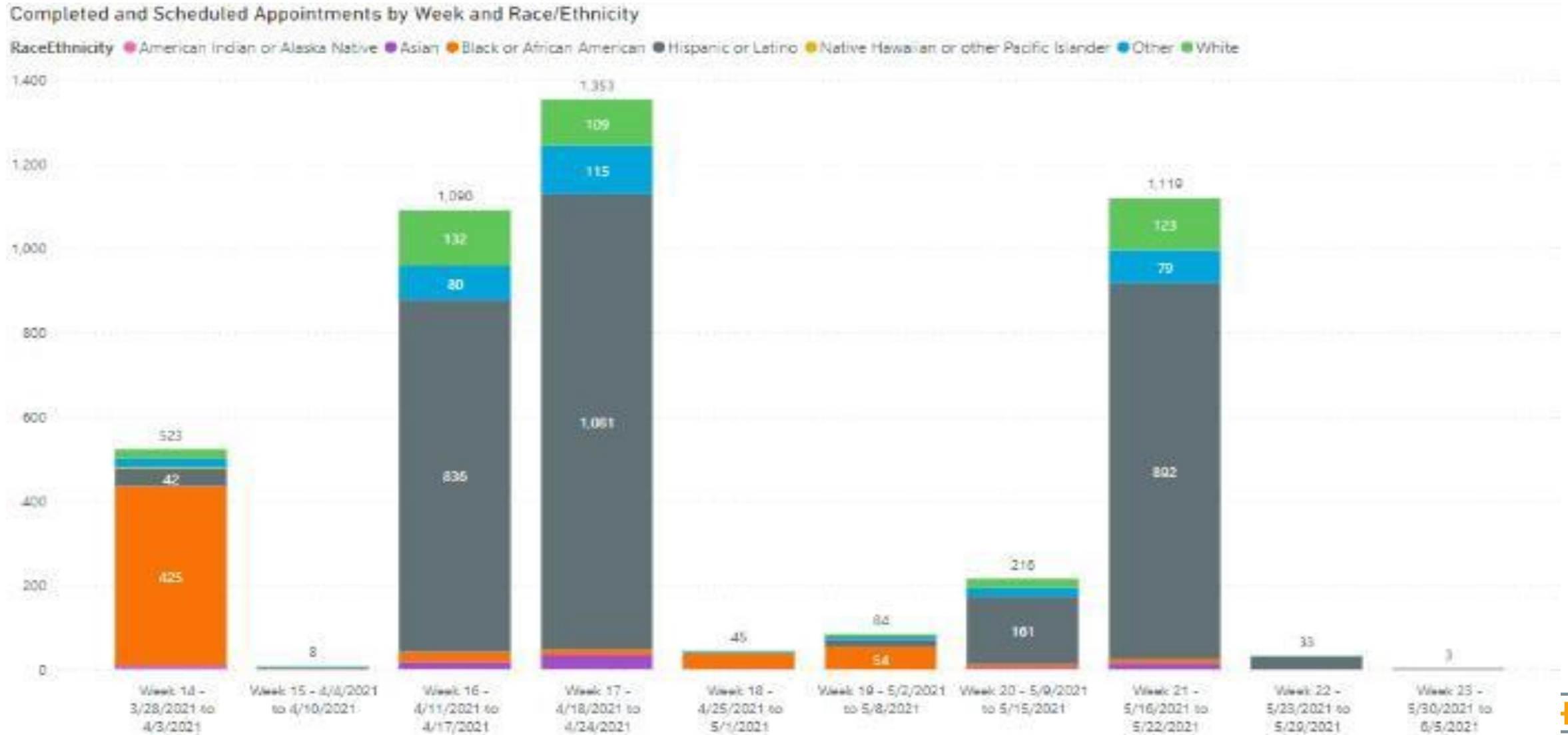

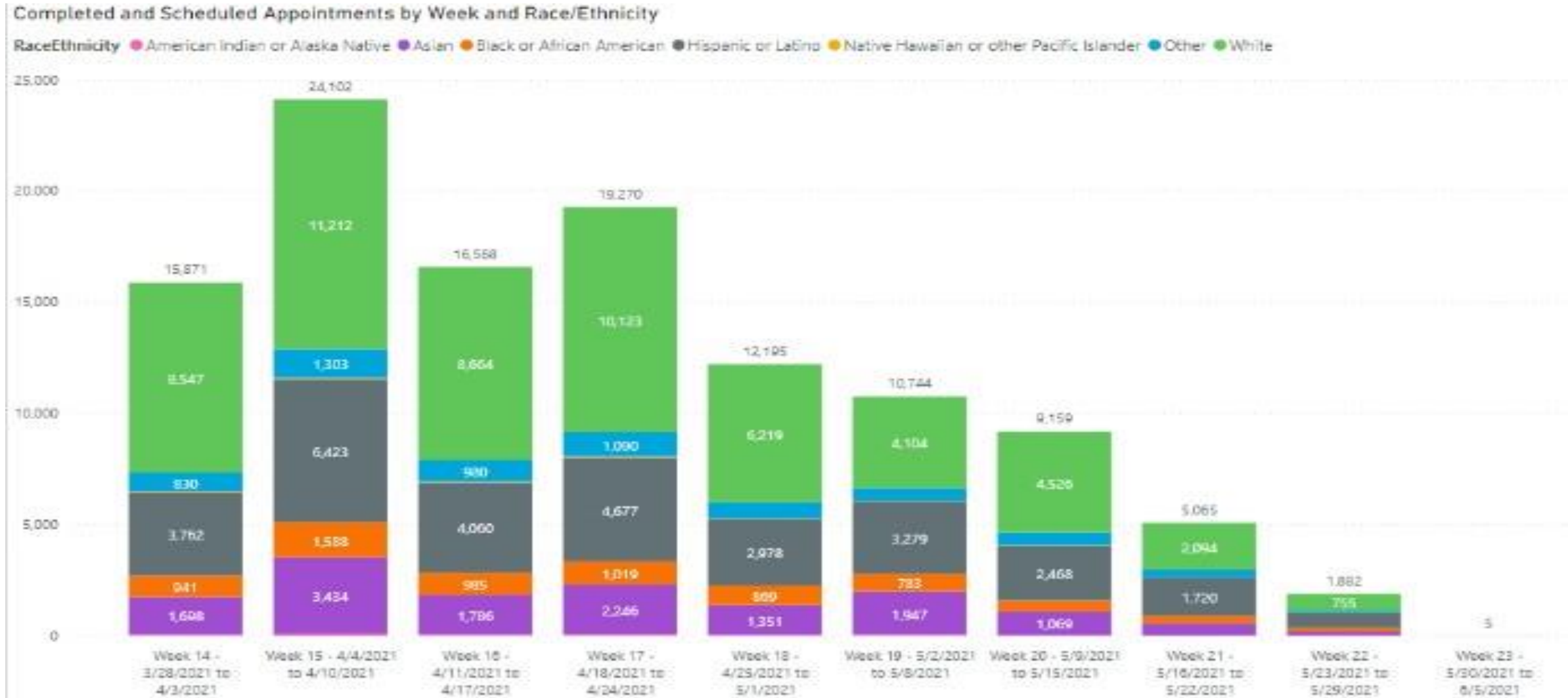

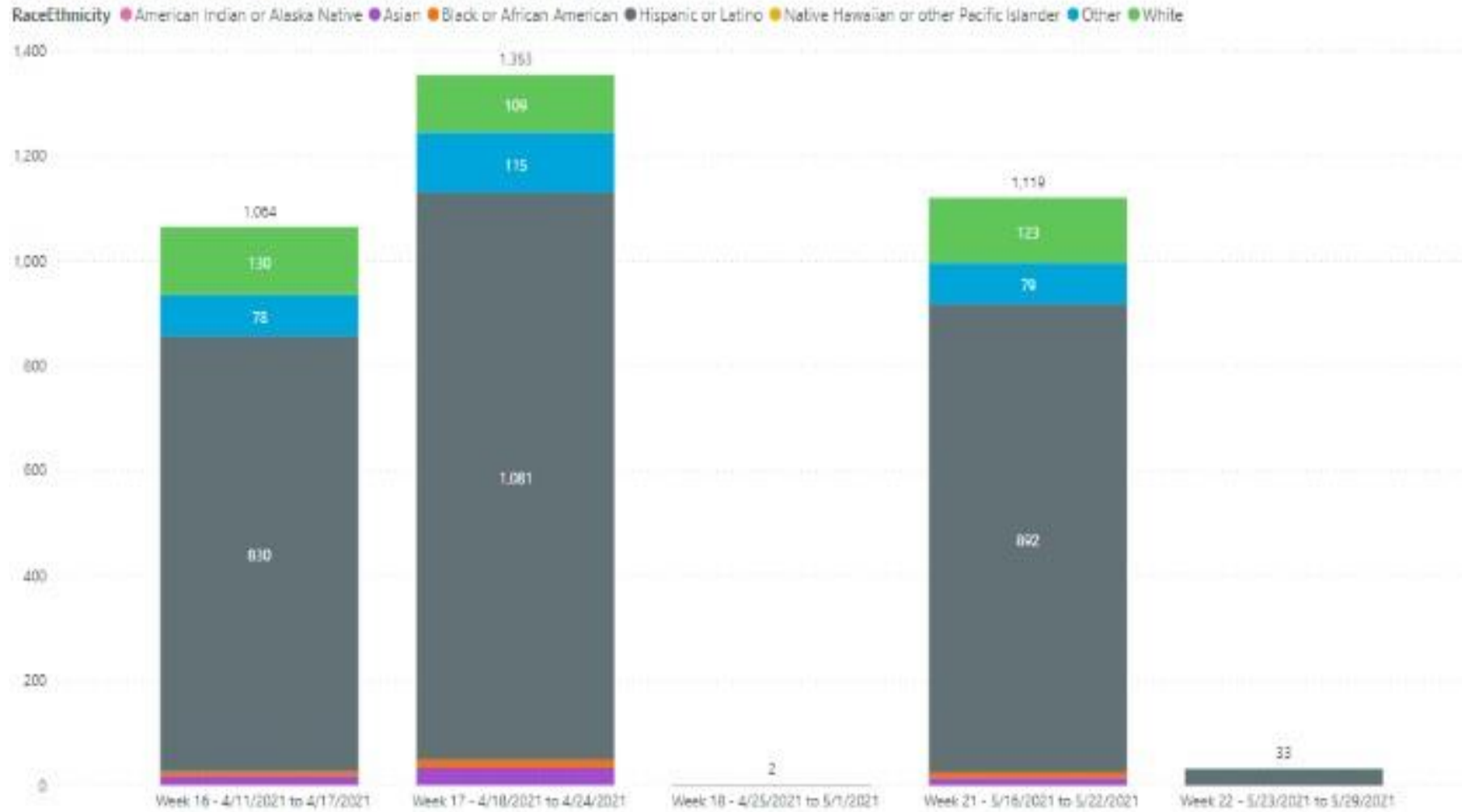

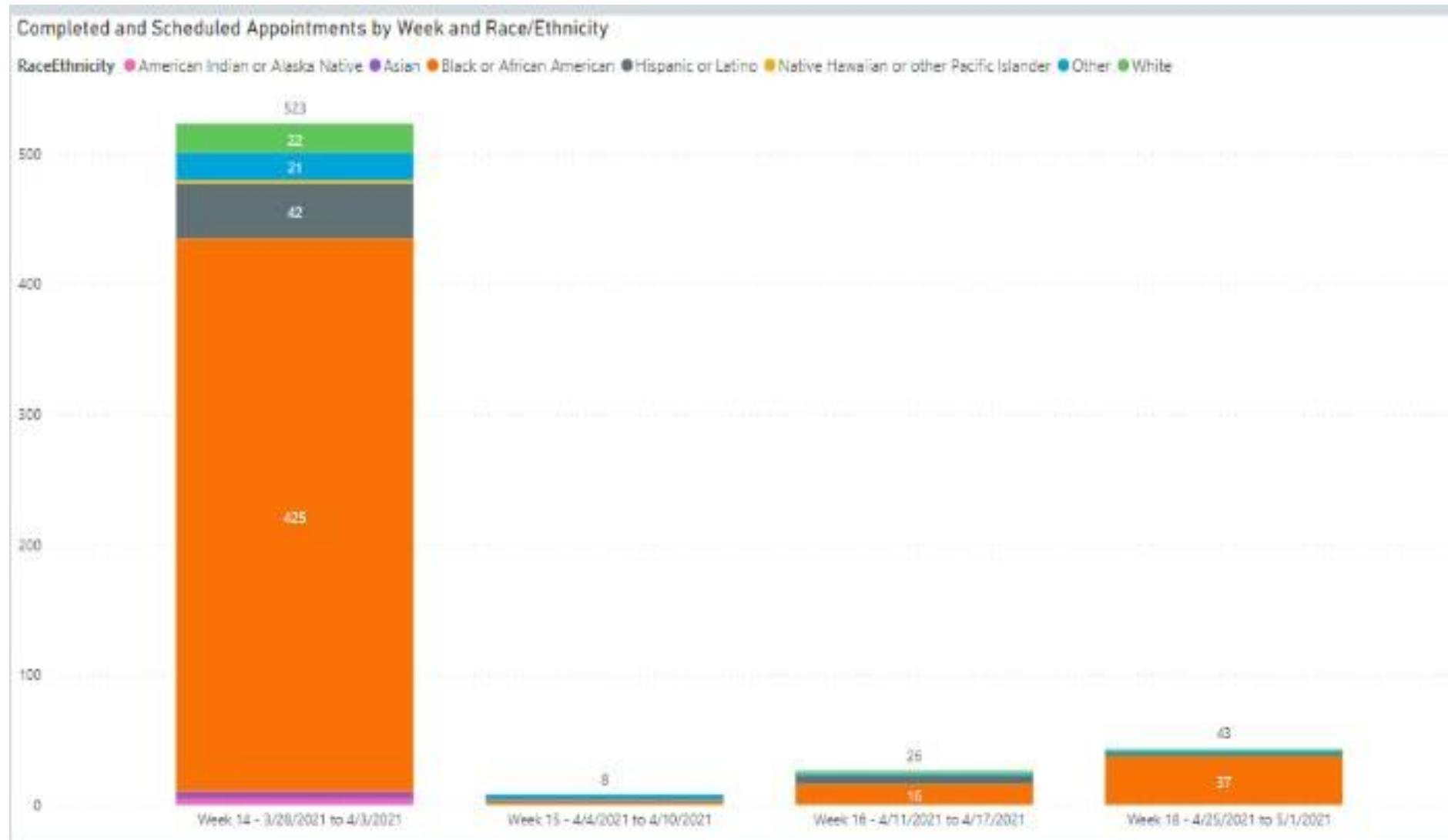
