




Percentage of COVID-19 Vaccination Administered to **Asians** by Week of Clinic, Austin Public Health, 2021






Percentage of COVID-19 Vaccination Administered to **Blacks** by Week of Clinic, Austin Public Health, 2021




Percentage of COVID-19 Vaccinations Administered to **Hispanics** by Week of Clinic, Austin Public Health, 2021






COVID-19 Travis County New Confirmed Cases






Between Counties with Large Metropolitan Areas






City of Austin - Travis County COVID-19 Count of Weekly Hospitalizations by Age Group (Austin MSA)






COVID-19 Austin MSA Current Hospitalizations








Hospitalizations as of 5/30/21








City of Austin - Travis County COVID-19 Count of Weekly Hospitalizations by Race/Ethnicity (Austin MSA)




Hospitalizations by Race and Ethnicity




COVID-19 Deaths

Between Counties with Large Metropolitan Areas






Percentage of Blacks by County Population and COVID -19 Deaths















Increased Vaccine Distribution in At-Risk Communities




Completed and Scheduled Appointments by Week and Race/Ethnicity






Mass Vaccination Sites




Pop-Up Vaccination Sites – Sacred Heart
