Posting Language

Authorize award of a multi-term contract with ITS Plus, Inc., to provide video detection equipment, installation services and training, for up to three years for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,500,000.

For the goods and services required for this solicitation, there were no subcontracting opportunities; therefore, no subcontracting goals were established).

Additional Backup Information:

The contract will provide cameras and ancillary equipment and services in support of the City's Video Imaging Vehicle Detection System (VIVDS) that monitors traffic signals on local roadways. The VIVDS system detects approaching or departing vehicles and bicycles in multiple traffic lanes, allowing controllers to alter signal control to improve traffic flow. The equipment will be installed to replace existing devices that have been damaged or reached their end of life.
