Additional Backup Information:

This ordinance repeals Ordinance No. 20200812-003 and establishes authorized strength at 1,257 and the number of positions at each rank of the Austin Fire Department effective October 1, 2021. Of the total authorized strength of 1,257: three Lieutenant positions and three Fire Specialist positions take effect on September 30, 2022.

The number of positions in the Lieutenant classification is increasing by three from the number in existence immediately before the effective date of this ordinance to staff a new fire station.

The number of positions in the Fire Specialist classification is increasing by three from the number in existence immediately before the effective date of this ordinance to staff a new fire station.

The number of positions in the Firefighter classification is increasing by ten from the number in existence immediately before the effective date of this ordinance to staff a new fire station.
