BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

- 15 **PART 1.** A special municipal election shall be held in the City of Austin on
- November 2, 2021, on the question of authorizing the City Council to convey or
- 17 lease certain parkland and providing the terms and conditions under which such a
- conveyance or lease could be made. The ballot shall be prepared to permit voting
- 19 "Yes" or "No" on the Proposition:

- 21 Proposition B: Ballot Language TBD
- PART 2. The election shall be conducted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00
- 23 p.m. The location of the main early voting polling place, the dates and hours for
- early voting, and the early voting clerk's official mailing address are provided in
- 25 Exhibit A, attached and incorporated as a part of this ordinance.
- 26 **PART 3**. A direct electronic recording voting system, as the term is defined in Title
- 8 of the Texas Election Code, shall be used for early voting and for voting conducted
- on election day. The central counting station is established at the Travis County
- 29 Elections Division, 5501 Airport Boulevard, Austin, Texas.
- 30 **PART 4.** Notice of this election shall be posted and published in accordance with
- state law. The notice shall be posted, in both English and Spanish, in the office of
- 32 the City Clerk and at the City Hall notice kiosk not later than the 21st day before
- election day. Notice of this election shall be published one time, in English and
- 34 Spanish, not earlier than the 30th day before the date of the election or later than the
- 35 10th day before the date of the election, in a newspaper of general circulation in the
- 36 City of Austin.

In accordance with Chapter 271 of the Texas Election Code, the November 2, 2021 special municipal election may be held jointly with the various political subdivisions that share territory with the City of Austin and that are holding elections on that day. The City Clerk may enter and sign joint election agreements with other political subdivisions for this purpose, and their terms as stated in the agreements are hereby adopted.
43 44 45 46	PART 6 . The Council finds that the need to immediately begin required preparations for this election constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
