This action will authorize negotiation and execution of a new agreement with African American Youth Harvest Foundation (AAYHF) to address mental, physical and social health issues that are negatively impacting African Americans and Hispanics residing in the North-Central and Eastern areas of Travis County through a direct and wraparound support-service-model. The scope of services will include mental health and stress management workshops; health education and awareness; wraparound and basic needs support; referrals to advanced care as required; and establishment of a feedback loop to ensure the community's voice is carried forward into future efforts by AAYHF, Austin Public Health, and other partners in the field

AAYHF is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that works cooperatively with local school districts and institutions of higher education to identify barriers preventing academic achievement and eliminate the academic achievement gap between African Americans and other at-risk populations.
