ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Since 1996, the Department of Family and Protective Services (TDFPS) has funded the 78744 Dove Springs Community Youth Development (CYD) Program with a goal of preventing juvenile delinquency through the provision of community-based prevention and remediation programs in the Dove Springs 78744 zip code area. TDFPS has identified the 78744 area as having as one of the top 25 statewide areas with high incidence of juvenile crime.

This funding will allow Austin Public Health's CYD Program use a positive youth development approach to meet the goal of assisting communities in alleviating conditions in the family and community that lead to juvenile crime. Services will be provided to youth ages 10 to 17 years old who live and/or attend school in the 78744 zip code.

The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, Austin Public Health Department's need for continued funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
